I believe the answer to these challenges is in one of my favorite Scriptures. Proverbs 3:5-6, "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding. In all your ways, acknowledge Him and He will direct your path".

Spiritual Growth Resources

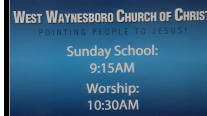


Christian Standard: The Christian Standard is a bi-monthly magazine and is an excellent resource for any believer desiring spiritual growth, especially leaders.
