

Daily Suggested Scripture Reading for the Month of June
(New King James Version)

- 1st **Isaiah 25:1** – “O Lord, thou art my God; I will exalt thee, I will praise thy name; for thou hast done wonderful things; thy counsels of old are faithfulness and truth.”
- 2nd **Psalms 150:6** - “Let every thing that hath breath praise the LORD. Praise ye the .”
- 3rd **Psalms 28:7** - “The LORD is my strength and my shield; my heart trusted in him, and I am helped: therefore my heart greatly rejoiceth; and with my song will I praise him.”
- 4th **Psalms 103:1** – “Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name.”
- 5th **Psalms 63:3-4** – “Because thy lovingkindness is better than life, my lips shall praise thee. Thus will I bless thee while I live: I will lift up my hands in thy name.”
- 6th **Psalms 9:1** – “I will praise thee, O LORD, with my whole heart; I will shew forth all thy marvelous works.”
- 7th **Acts:16:25** – “And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them.”
- 8th **Psalms 42:11** – “Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and why art thou disquieted within me? hope thou in God: for I shall yet praise him, who is the health of my countenance, and my God.”
- 9th **Psalms 145:3** – “Great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised; and his greatness is unsearchable.”
- 10th **Psalms 139:13-14** – “For thou hast possessed my reins: thou hast covered me in my mother's womb. I will praise thee; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made: marvellous are thy works; and that my soul knoweth right well.”
- 11th **Psalms 71:8** – “Let my mouth be filled with thy praise and with thy honour all the day.”
- 12th **Psalms 34:1** – “I will bless the LORD at all times: his praise shall continually be in my mouth.”
- 13th **Revelation 5:13** – “And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, be unto him that sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever.”
- 14th **Colossians 3:16** - “Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.”
- 15th **Psalms 105:1** - “O give thanks unto the LORD; call upon his name: make known his deeds among the people.”
- 16th **Psalms 145:1** - “I will extol thee, my God, O king; and I will bless thy name for ever

and ever.”

- 17th **Romans 14:11** - “For it is written, As I live, saith the Lord, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God.”
- 18th **Isaiah 12:4** - “And in that day shall ye say, Praise the LORD, call upon his name, declare his doings among the people, make mention that his name is exalted.”
- 19th **Psalms 56:4** – “In God I will praise his word, in God I have put my trust; I will not fear what flesh can do unto me.”
- 20th **Jeremiah 17:14** – “Heal me, O LORD, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved: for thou art my praise.”
- 21st **Psalms 66:17** – “I cried unto him with my mouth, and he was extolled with my tongue.”
- 22nd **Acts 2:46-47** - “And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart, Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved.”
- 23rd **Psalms 119:7** – “I will praise thee with uprightness of heart, when I shall have learned thy righteous judgments.”
- 24th **Psalms 108:3** - “I will praise thee, O LORD, among the people: and I will sing praises unto thee among the nations.”
- 25th **Daniel 2:23** - “I thank thee, and praise thee, O thou God of my fathers, who hast given me wisdom and might, and hast made known unto me now what we desired of thee: for thou hast now made known unto us the king's matter.”
- 26th **Job 1:20-21** - “Then Job arose, and rent his mantle, and shaved his head, and fell down upon the ground, and worshipped, And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD.”
- 27th **Psalms 100:4-5** - “Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name. For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations.”
- 28th **Exodus 15:2** The LORD is my strength and song, and he is become my salvation: he is my God, and I will prepare him an habitation; my father's God, and I will exalt him –
