

Daily Suggested Scripture Reading for the Month of August
(New King James Version)

- 1st **John 15:12-13** – “This is my commandment, That ye love one another, as I have loved you. Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.”
- 2nd **Ephesians 4:32** – “And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.”
- 3rd **Matthew 6:14-15** – “For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses!”
- 4th **John 13:34** – “A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.”
- 5th **Romans 5:8** – “But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.”
- 6th **I John 4:7-8** – “Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God. He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love.”
- 7th **1 John 4:16** “And we have known and believed the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him.”
- 8th **I Corinthians 13:1-2** – “Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not charity, I am become as sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal. And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, I am nothing.”
- 9th **I Corinthians 13:3** – “And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, and have not charity, it profiteth me nothing”
- 10th **I Corinthians 13:13** – “And now abideth faith, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these is charity”
- 11th **I Peter 4:8** – “And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves: for charity shall cover the multitude of sins.”
- 12th **1 Corinthians 15:58** – “be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.”
- 13th **Romans 12:10** – “Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another.”
- 14th **John 13:35** – “By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.”

Daily Suggested Scripture Reading for the Month of August
(New King James Version)

- 15th **I Corinthians 16:14** – “Let all your things be done with charity.”
- 16th **Leviticus 19:18** – “Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people. But thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself: I am the LORD.”
- 17th **I John 4:19-20** – “We love him, because he first loved us. If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen?”
- 18th **Luke 6:35** – “We love him, because he first loved us. If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen?”
- 19th **Mark 12:30-31** – “And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment. And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.”
- 20th **Colossians 3:13-15** – “Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye. And above all these things put on charity, which is the bond of perfectness. And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful.”
- 21st **John 14:15** – “If ye love me, keep my commandments.”
- 22nd **Ephesians 2:4-5** – “But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us, Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;).”
- 23rd **Matthew 5:16** – “Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven”
- 24th **Matthew 22:37-39** – “Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.”
- 25th **Matthew 4:21** – “And this commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also”
- 26th **Luke 6:27-31** – “But I say unto you which hear, Love your enemies, do good to them which hate you, Bless them that curse you, and pray for them which despitefully use you. And unto him that smiteth thee on the one cheek offer also the other; and him that taketh away thy cloak forbid not to take thy coat also. Give to every man that asketh of thee; and of him that taketh away thy goods ask them not again. And as ye would that men should do to you, do ye also to them likewise.”

- 27th **Matthew 5:43-44** – “Ye have heard that it hath been said, Thou shalt love thy neighbour, and hate thine enemy. But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you.”
- 28th **Matthew 5:45-46** – “That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust. For if ye love them which love you, what reward have ye? do not even the publicans the same?”
- 29th **Matthew 5:47-48** – “And if ye salute your brethren only, what do ye more than others? do not even the publicans so? Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.”
- 30th **Matthew 25:35:40** – “For I was an hungred, and ye gave me meat: I was thirsty, and ye gave me drink: I was a stranger, and ye took me in: Naked, and ye clothed me: I was sick, and ye visited me: I was in prison, and ye came unto me. Then shall the righteous answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an hungred, and fed thee? or thirsty, and gave thee drink? When saw we thee a stranger, and took thee in? or naked, and clothed thee? Or when saw we thee sick, or in prison, and came unto thee? And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me.”
- 31st **Mark 10:45** – “For even the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many.”
