

*Daily Suggested Scripture Reading for the Month of January*  
*(New King James Version)*

- 1<sup>st</sup> **Matthew 6:33** – “But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.”
- 2<sup>nd</sup> **Matthew 22:37** – “Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.”
- 3<sup>rd</sup> **Colossians 3:17** – “And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him.”
- 4<sup>th</sup> **I Samuel 2:2** – “There is none holy as the LORD: for there is none beside thee: neither is there any rock like our God.”
- 5<sup>th</sup> **John 4:23** – “But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.”
- 6<sup>th</sup> **Isaiah 25:1** – “O Lord thou art my God; I will exalt thee, I will praise thy name; for thou hast done wonderful things; thy counsels of old are faithful and truth.”
- 7<sup>th</sup> **Hebrews 12:28-29** – “Wherefore we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear: <sup>29</sup>For our God is a consuming fire.”
- 8<sup>th</sup> **John 4:24** – “God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.”
- 9<sup>th</sup> **Proverbs 3:9-10** – “Honour the LORD with thy substance, and with the firstfruits of all thine increase: <sup>10</sup>So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine.”
- 10<sup>th</sup> **I Chronicles 16:23-24** – “Sing unto the LORD, all the earth; shew forth from day to day his salvation. <sup>24</sup>Declare his glory among the heathen; his marvellous works among all nations.”
- 11<sup>th</sup> **I Chronicles 16:25-26** – “For great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised: he also is to be feared above all gods. <sup>26</sup>For all the gods of the people are idols: but the LORD made the heavens.”
- 12<sup>th</sup> **I Chronicles 16:27-29** – “Glory and honour are in his presence; strength and gladness are in his place. <sup>28</sup>Give unto the LORD, ye kindreds of the people, give unto the LORD glory and strength. <sup>29</sup>Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name: bring an offering, and come before him: worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness.”
- 13<sup>th</sup> **I Chronicles 16:30-31** – “Fear before him, all the earth: the world also shall be stable, that it be not moved. <sup>31</sup>Let the heavens be glad, and let the earth rejoice: and let men say among the nations, The LORD reigneth.”
- 14<sup>th</sup> **Psalms 86:9-10** – “All nations whom thou hast made shall come and worship before thee, O Lord; and shall glorify thy name. <sup>10</sup>For thou art great, and doest wondrous

things: thou art God alone.”

- 15<sup>th</sup> **Deuteronomy 6:4-5** – “Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD: <sup>5</sup> And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.”
- 16<sup>th</sup> **Exodus 20:2-4** – “I am the LORD thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. <sup>3</sup> Thou shalt have no other gods before me. <sup>4</sup> Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth.”
- 17<sup>th</sup> **Exodus 20:5-6** – “Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me; <sup>6</sup> And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.”
- 18<sup>th</sup> **Exodus 20:7-8** – “Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain <sup>8</sup> Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy.”
- 19<sup>th</sup> **Psalms 95** – “<sup>1</sup> O come, let us sing unto the LORD: let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation. <sup>2</sup> Let us come before his presence with thanksgiving, and make a joyful noise unto him with psalms. <sup>3</sup> For the LORD *is* a great God, and a great King above all gods. <sup>4</sup> In his hand *are* the deep places of the earth: the strength of the hills *is* his also. <sup>5</sup> The sea *is* his, and he made it: and his hands formed the dry *land*. <sup>6</sup> O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before the LORD our maker.”
- 20<sup>th</sup> **Romans 11:36** – “For of him, and through him, and to him, are all things: to whom be glory for ever. Amen.”
- 21<sup>st</sup> **John 13:34-35** – “Because thy lovingkindness is better than life, my lips shall praise thee. <sup>4</sup> Thus will I bless thee while I live: I will lift up my hands in thy name.”
- 22<sup>nd</sup> **Psalms 104:33** – “I will sing unto the LORD as long as I live: I will sing praise to my God while I have my being.”
- 23<sup>rd</sup> **John 9:38** – “And he said, Lord, I believe. And he worshipped him.”
- 24<sup>th</sup> **I Corinthians 14:25** – “And thus are the secrets of his heart made manifest; and so falling down on his face he will worship God, and report that God is in you of a truth..”
- 25<sup>th</sup> **Revelation 48:11** – “Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.”
- 26<sup>th</sup> **Galatians 2:20** – “I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me”
- 27<sup>th</sup> **Psalms 29:2** - “Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name; worship the LORD in the

beauty of holiness.”

- 28<sup>th</sup> **Luke 4:8** – “And Jesus answered and said unto him, Get thee behind me, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.”
- 29<sup>th</sup> **Psalm 100** – “Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all ye lands. <sup>2</sup>Serve the LORD with gladness: come before his presence with singing. <sup>3</sup>Know ye that the LORD he is God: it is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture. <sup>4</sup>Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name. <sup>5</sup>For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations.”
- 30<sup>th</sup> **John 12:26** - “If any man serve me, let him follow me; and where I am, there shall also my servant be: if any man serve me, him will my Father honour.”
- 31<sup>st</sup> **Revelation 14:7** – “Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.”
