

Daily Suggested Scripture Reading for the Month of February
(New King James Version)

- 1st **Ephesians 6:18** – “Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints.”
- 2nd **I Thessalonians 5:16-18** – “Rejoice evermore. ¹⁷Pray without ceasing. ¹⁸In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.”
- 3rd **Psalms 116:1-2** – “I love the LORD, because he hath heard my voice and my supplications. ²Because he hath inclined his ear unto me, therefore will I call upon him as long as I live.”
- 4th **James 5:17-18** – “Elias was a man subject to like passions as we are, and he prayed earnestly that it might not rain: and it rained not on the earth by the space of three years and six months. ¹⁸And he prayed again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth brought forth her fruit.”
- 5th **Psalms 119:147-149** – “I prevented the dawning of the morning, and cried: I hoped in thy word. ¹⁴⁸Mine eyes prevent the night watches, that I might meditate in thy word. ¹⁴⁹Hear my voice according unto thy lovingkindness: O LORD, quicken me according to thy judgment.”
- 6th **Psalms 130: 1-5** – “Out of the depths have I cried unto thee, O LORD. ²Lord, hear my voice: let thine ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications. ³If thou, LORD, shouldest mark iniquities, O Lord, who shall stand? ⁴But there is forgiveness with thee, that thou mayest be feared. ⁵I wait for the LORD, my soul doth wait, and in his word do I hope.”
- 7th **Romans 12:12** – “Rejoicing in hope; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer.”
- 8th **Philippians 4:6-7** – “Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. ⁷And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.”
- 9th **Psalms 40:1-3** – “I waited patiently for the LORD; and he inclined unto me, and heard my cry. ²He brought me up also out of an horrible pit, out of the miry clay, and set my feet upon a rock, and established my goings. ³And he hath put a new song in my mouth, even praise unto our God: many shall see it, and fear, and shall trust in the LORD.”
- 10th **I Chronicles 16:10-11** – “Glory ye in his holy name: let the heart of them rejoice that seek the LORD. ¹¹Seek the LORD and his strength, seek his face continually.”
- 11th **I John 5:14** – “And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us.”
- 12th **Colossians 4:2-3** – “Continue in prayer, and watch in the same with thanksgiving;

³ Withal praying also for us, that God would open unto us a door of utterance, to speak the mystery of Christ, for which I am also in bonds.”

- 13th **Mark 11:24** – “Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.”
- 14th **Jeremiah 29:12** – “Then shall ye call upon me, and ye shall go and pray unto me, and I will hearken unto you.”
- 15th **Psalms 145:18** – “The LORD is nigh unto all them that call upon him, to all that call upon him in truth.”
- 16th **Deuteronomy 9:25-26** – “Thus I fell down before the LORD forty days and forty nights, as I fell down at the first; because the LORD had said he would destroy you. ²⁶I prayed therefore unto the LORD, and said, O Lord GOD, destroy not thy people and thine inheritance, which thou hast redeemed through thy greatness, which thou hast brought forth out of Egypt with a mighty hand.”
- 17th **Mark 14:32-35** – “And they came to a place which was named Gethsemane: and he saith to his disciples, Sit ye here, while I shall pray. ³³ And he taketh with him Peter and James and John, and began to be sore amazed, and to be very heavy; ³⁴ And saith unto them, My soul is exceeding sorrowful unto death: tarry ye here, and watch. ³⁵ And he went forward a little, and fell on the ground, and prayed that, if it were possible, the hour might pass from him.”
- 18th **Mark 14:36-39** – “And he said, Abba, Father, all things are possible unto thee; take away this cup from me: nevertheless not what I will, but what thou wilt. ³⁷ And he cometh, and findeth them sleeping, and saith unto Peter, Simon, sleepest thou? couldest not thou watch one hour? ³⁸ Watch ye and pray, lest ye enter into temptation. The spirit truly is ready, but the flesh is weak. ³⁹ And again he went away, and prayed, and spake the same words.”
- 19th **Matthew 6:6** – “But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly.”
- 20th **Matthew 6:7** – “But when ye pray, use not vain repetitions, as the heathen do: for they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking.”
- 21st **Psalms 18:6** – “In my distress I called upon the LORD, and cried unto my God: he heard my voice out of his temple, and my cry came before him, even into his ears.”
- 22nd **I Peter 4:7** – “But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch unto prayer.”
- 23rd **John 14:13** – “And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father

may be glorified in the Son.”

- 24th **Luke 6:27-28** – “But I say unto you which hear, Love your enemies, do good to them which hate you, ²⁸Bless them that curse you, and pray for them which despitefully use you.”
- 25th **Hebrews 4:16** – “Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.”
- 26th **Jeremiah 33:3** – “Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and show thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not.”
- 27th **Psalms 88:1-2** - “O lord God of my salvation, I have cried day and night before thee:
²Let my prayer come before thee: incline thine ear unto my cry.”
- 28th **John 15:16** – “Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you.”
