

Daily Suggested Scripture Reading for the Month of February
(King James Version)

- 1st **Philippians 4:6** – “Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.”
- 2nd **John 15:7** – “If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.”
- 3rd **James 1:6** – “But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed.”
- 4th **1 Thessalonians 5:17-18** – “Pray without ceasing. In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.”
- 5th **Romans 8:26** – “Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.”
- 6th **Matthew 6:6** – “But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly.”
- 7th **Matthew 6:7** – “But when ye pray, use not vain repetitions, as the heathen [do]: for they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking.”
- 8th **Luke 11:9** – “And I say unto you, Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you.”
- 9th **1 Timothy 2:1** – “I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men.”
- 10th **Jeremiah 3:3** – “Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and shew thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not.”
- 11th **Matthew 26:41** – “Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.”
- 12th **1 Timothy 2:5** – “For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus.”
- 13th **James 5:16** – “Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.”
- 14th **Matthew 6:5-6** – “And when thou prayest, thou shalt not be as the hypocrites are: for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.
But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly.”

Daily Suggested Scripture Reading for the Month of February
(King James Version)

- 15th **Matthew 6:7-8** – “But when ye pray, use not vain repetitions, as the heathen do: for they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking. Be not ye therefore like unto them: for your Father knoweth what things ye have need of, before ye ask him.”
- 16th **Ephesians 6:18** – “Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints.”
- 17th **Psalms 34:17** – “The righteous cry, and the LORD heareth, and delivereth them out of all their troubles..”
- 18th **Luke 18:16** – “And he spake a parable unto them [to this end], that men ought always to pray, and not to faint.”
- 19th **Matthew 6:9-13** – “After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.”
- 20th **I John 3:22** – “And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight.”
- 21st **I John 5:14-15** – “And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.”
- 22nd **Jeremiah 29:11-12** – “For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end. Then shall ye call upon me, and ye shall go and pray unto me, and I will hearken unto you.”
- 23rd **Jeremiah 29:13-15** – “And ye shall seek me, and find [me], when ye shall search for me with all your heart. And I will be found of you, saith the LORD: and I will turn away your captivity, and I will gather you from all the nations, and from all the places whither I have driven you, saith the LORD; and I will bring you again into the place whence I caused you to be carried away captive. Because ye have said, The LORD hath raised us up prophets in Babylon.”
- 24th **II Chronicles 7:14** – “If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.”
- 25th **Jeremiah 29:12** – “Then shall ye call upon me, and ye shall go and pray unto me, and I will hearken unto you.”
- 26th **Mark 11:22-23** – “And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. For verily I

say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.”

27th **Mark 11:24-25** - “Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them. And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.”

28th **Jude 20-22** – “But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost, Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life. And of some have compassion, making a difference.”
