

Medical Patients and Pathways Clients by age





- The Epic program was presented in almost every middle and high school in Josephine County and several in Jackson County this past year.
- 2,339 clients and students were served in 2019

PROGRAMS:

ACCREDITED MEDICAL CENTER: EARLY PREGNANCY CARE & SUPPORT



The PCC Medical Center serves as a gateway to proper OB care, offering early pregnancy health services, including limited OB ultrasound and support in decision making at no cost.

SERVED IN 2019: 301 Patients were provided 536 Medical Appointments

EPIC: SEXUAL HEALTH PROGRAM PROMOTING ABSTINENCE



Epic empowers students to use decision-making strategies to make healthy choices about sex, relationships, and abstinence.

SERVED IN 2019: 1,770 students and 206 at Unaltered

PATHWAYS: PREGNANCY AND EARLY PARENTING SUPPORT AND EDUCATION



Pathways prepares and equips parents during pregnancy and early parenthood to make healthy decisions for themselves and their families.
