My Daily Medication

Introduction:

It is the Lord's will to heal. Healing is a part of the atoning sacrifice of Jesus Christ. The Word of God tells us that man shall not live by bread alone but by every word that proceed out of the mouth of God (Matt. 4:4). The Word of God is a medicine that heals our body. **Proverbs 4:20-22** "20 My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. 21 Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. 22 For they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh."

As we meditate on the Word of God daily, I believe that God will do a mighty miracle in our lives. We are told to meditate on the word day and night, (**Jos. 1:8**). Our delight should be in pondering (meditating) on the word of God (**Psa. 1:2**).

God is yet a healer, He yet works miracles. As we stand on the word of God let's believe that whatever sickness or disease we may have that it is not too hard for God to heal. The word lets us know that Jesus Christ came to destroy the works of the devil (**1 Jn. 3:8**). The last part of 1 Jn 3:8 as read in the Amplified Bible is vitally important ".....The reason the Son of God was made manifest (visible) was to undo (destroy, loosen, and dissolve) the works the devil [has done]." Sickness is the work of the devil, but we must believe that Jesus Christ came to loose us from whatever sickness or disease the devil attempts to put on us.

It's important that we pray the scripture, the Word of God is the foundation of our receiving deliverance. "Faith in God is not a leap in the dark, it stands on the authority of the word. **Romans 4:17** (KJV) "17 (As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, even God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were." Again listen to the reading of the Amplified, **Romans 4:17 (AMPC)** 17 As it is written, I have made you the father of many nations. [He was appointed our father] in the sight of God in Whom he believed, Who gives life to the dead and speaks of the nonexistent things that [He has foretold and promised] as if they [already] existed.

God speaks of things that has not yet come into existence as though they already exist. Speak what God said in the word, say it, because death and life is in the power of the tongue (**Prov. 18:21**).

This booklet is design for you to have a tool filled with the word of God that focus on the healing power of God. Read the word daily and pray the word daily. Let what the Lord said and did in the word form the foundation of your daily prayer concerning healing. Use this booklet to build your faith on a daily basis. “so then faith cometh by hearing, hearing by the word of God. (**Rom. 10:17**).

Expect God to work a miracle in your life as well as someone else’s life that need the Lord to heal their body. Believe **Eph. 3:20** - “20 Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us,”

In the words of the Late Bishop G. E. Patterson “Be Healed, Be Delivered, and Be Set Free.”

Exodus 15:26 (CWSB) 26 And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the Lord thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the Lord that healeth thee.

Psalms 103:2-3 (CWSB) 2 Bless -- the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: 3 Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases;

Luke 5:15 (CWSB) But so much the more went there a fame abroad of him: and great multitudes came together to hear, and to be healed by him of their infirmities.

2 Kings 20:1-6 (CWSB) 1 In those days was Hezekiah sick unto death. And the prophet Isaiah the son of Amoz came to him, and said unto him, Thus saith the Lord, Set thine house in order; for thou shalt die, and not live. 2 Then he turned -- his face to the wall, and prayed unto the Lord, saying, 3 I beseech thee, O Lord, remember now -- how I have walked before thee in truth and with a perfect heart, and have done that which is good in thy sight. And Hezekiah wept sore. 4 And it came to pass, before Isaiah was gone out into the middle court, that the word of the Lord came to him, saying, 5 Turn again, and tell Hezekiah the captain of my people, Thus saith the Lord, the God of David thy father, I have heard -- thy prayer, I have seen -- thy tears: behold, I will heal thee: on the third day thou shalt go up unto the house of the Lord. 6 And I will add unto thy days fifteen years; and I will deliver thee and -- this city out of the hand of the king of Assyria; and I will defend this city for mine own sake, and for my servant David's sake.

James 5:14-15 (CWSB) Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord: 15 And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

Mark 10:51-52 (CWSB) 51 And Jesus answered and said unto him, What wilt thou that I should do unto thee? -- The blind man said unto him, Lord, that I might receive my sight. 52 And Jesus said unto him, Go thy way; thy faith hath made thee whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way.

John 6:2 (CWSB) And a great multitude followed him, because they saw his miracles which he did on them that were diseased.

Malachi 4:2 (CWSB) 2 But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall.

Luke 9:6 (CWSB) 6 And they departed, and went through the towns, preaching the gospel, and healing everywhere.

Acts 10:38 (CWSB) 38 How God anointed -- Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

Jeremiah 8:22 (CWSB) 22 Is there no balm in Gilead; -- is there no physician there? why then is not the health of the daughter of my people recovered?

Jeremiah 17:7-8 (CWSB) 7 Blessed is the man that trusteth in the Lord, and whose hope the Lord is. 8 For he shall be as a tree planted by the waters, and that spreadeth out her roots by the river, and shall not see when heat cometh, but her leaf shall be green; and shall not be careful in the year of drought, neither shall cease from yielding fruit.

Mark 1:34 (CWSB) 34 And he healed many that were sick of divers diseases, and cast out many devils; and suffered not the devils to speak, because they knew him.

Psalms 30:2 (CWSB) 2 O Lord my God, I cried unto thee, and thou hast healed me.

Acts 4:30 (CWSB) 30 By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus.

John 4:49-53 (CWSB) 49 The nobleman saith unto him, Sir, come down ere my child die. 50 Jesus saith unto him, Go thy way; thy son liveth. And the man believed the word that Jesus had spoken unto him, and he went his way. 51 And as he was now going down, his servants met him, and told him, saying, Thy son liveth. 52 Then inquired he of them the hour when he began to amend. And they said unto him, Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever left him. 53 So the father knew that it was at the same hour, in the which Jesus said unto him, Thy son liveth: and himself believed, and his whole house.

John 5:6-9 (CWSB) 6 When Jesus saw him lie, and knew that he had been now a long time in that case, he saith unto him, Wilt thou be made whole? 7 The impotent man answered him, Sir, I have no man, -- when the water is troubled, to put me into the pool: but while I am coming, another steppeth down before me.

And -- immediately his leprosy was cleansed. 4 And Jesus saith unto him, See thou tell no man; but go thy way, show thyself to the priest, and offer the gift that Moses commanded, for a testimony unto them.

Matthew 8:14-17 (CWSB) 14 And when Jesus was come into Peter's house, he saw his wife's mother laid, and sick of a fever. 15 And he touched her hand, and the fever left her: and she arose, and ministered unto them. 16 When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed all that were sick: 17 That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.

Mark 2:10-12 (CWSB) 10 But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power on earth to forgive sins, (he saith to the sick of the palsy,) 11 I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy bed, and go thy way into thine house. 12 And immediately he arose, took up the bed, and went forth before them all; insomuch that they were all amazed, and glorified God, saying, We never saw it on this fashion.

Matthew 12:13 (CWSB) 13 Then saith he to the man, Stretch forth thine hand. And he stretched it forth; and it was restored whole, like as the other.

Matthew 9:27-30 (CWSB) 27 And when Jesus departed thence, two blind men followed him, crying, and saying, Thou son of David, have mercy on us. 28 And when he was come into the house, the blind men came to him: and Jesus saith unto them, Believe ye that I am able to do this? They said unto him, Yea, Lord. 29 Then touched he their eyes, saying, According to your faith be it unto you. 30 And their eyes were opened; and Jesus straitly charged them, saying, See that no man know it.

Matthew 12:22 (CWSB) 22 Then was brought unto him one possessed with a devil, blind, and dumb: and he healed him, insomuch that the blind and dumb both spake and saw.

Matthew 20:30-34 (CWSB) 30 And, behold, two blind men sitting by the way side, when they heard that Jesus passed by, cried out, saying, Have mercy on us, O Lord, thou son of David. 31 And the multitude rebuked them, because they should hold their peace: but they cried the more, saying, Have mercy on us, O Lord, thou son of David. 32 And Jesus stood still, and called them, and said, What will ye that I shall do unto you? 33 They say unto him, Lord, that our eyes may be opened. 34 So Jesus had compassion on them, and touched their eyes: and immediately their eyes received sight, and they followed him.

Matthew 9:20-22 (CWSB) 20 And, behold, a woman, which was diseased with an issue of blood twelve years, came behind him, and touched the hem of his garment: 21 For she said within herself, If I may but touch his garment, I shall be whole. 22 But Jesus turned him about, and when he saw her, he said, Daughter, be of good comfort; thy faith hath made thee whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour.

Matthew 9:35 (CWSB) 35 And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.

Matthew 14:14 (CWSB) 14 And Jesus went forth, and saw a great multitude, and was moved with compassion toward them, and he healed their sick.

Matthew 14:35-36 (CWSB) 35 And when the men of that place had knowledge of him, they sent out into all that country round about, and brought unto him all that were diseased; 36 And besought him that they might only touch the hem of his garment: and as many as touched were made perfectly whole.

Matthew 15:30-31 (CWSB) 30 And great multitudes came unto him, having with them those that were lame, blind, dumb, maimed, and many others, and cast them down at Jesus' feet; and he healed them: 31 Insomuch that the multitude wondered, when they saw the dumb to speak, the maimed to be whole, the lame to walk, and the blind to see: and they glorified the God of Israel.

Matthew 19:2 (CWSB) 2 And great multitudes followed him; and he healed them there.

Mark 6:5-6 (CWSB) 5 And he could there do no -- mighty work, save that he laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed them. 6 And he marveled because of their unbelief. And he went round about the villages, teaching.

Mark 6:55-56 (CWSB) 55 And ran through that whole region round about, and began to carry about in beds those that were sick, where they heard he was. 56 And whithersoever he entered, into villages, or cities, or country, they laid the sick in the streets, and besought him that they might touch if it were but the border of his garment: and as many as touched him were made whole.

Luke 4:40-41 (CWSB) 40 Now when the sun was setting, all they that had any sick with divers diseases brought them unto him; and he laid his hands on every one of them, and healed them. 41 And devils also came out of many, crying out, and saying, Thou art Christ the Son of God. And he rebuking them suffered them not to speak: for they knew that he was Christ.

Matthew 15:28 (CWSB) 28 Then Jesus answered and said unto her, O woman, great is thy faith: be it unto thee even as thou wilt. And -- her daughter was made whole from that very hour.

Mark 7:32-35 (CWSB) 32 And they bring unto him one that was deaf, and had an impediment in his speech; and they beseech him to put his hand upon him. 33 And he took him aside from the multitude, and put his fingers into his ears, and he spit, and touched his tongue;

34 And looking up to heaven, he sighed, and saith unto him, Ephphatha, that is, Be opened.

Luke 17:12-16 (CWSB) 12 And as he entered into a certain village, there met him ten men that were lepers, which stood afar off: 13 And they lifted up their voices, and said, Jesus, Master, have mercy on us. 14 And when he saw them, he said unto them, Go show yourselves unto the priests. 1 Corinthians 12:28 (CWSB) 28 And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues.

Acts 5:15-16 (CWSB) 15 Insomuch that they brought forth the sick into the streets, and laid them on beds and couches, that at the least the shadow of Peter passing by might overshadow some of them. 16 -- There came also a multitude out of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed every one.

Acts 28:8-9 (CWSB) 8 And it came to pass, that the father of Publius lay sick of a fever and of a bloody flux: to whom Paul entered in, and prayed, and laid his hands on him, and healed him. 9 So when this was done, others also, which had diseases in the island, came, and were healed:

Acts 9:40-42 (CWSB) 40 But Peter put them all forth, and kneeled down, and prayed; and turning him to the body said, Tabitha, arise. And she opened her eyes: and when she saw Peter, she sat up.

41 And he gave her his hand, and lifted her up, and when he had called the saints and widows, presented her alive. 42 And it was known throughout all Joppa; and many believed in the Lord.

Psalms 91:7-10 (CWSB) 7 A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but it shall not come nigh thee. 8 Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked. 9 Because thou hast made the Lord, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation; 10 There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling.

Jeremiah 17:14 (CWSB) 14 Heal me, O Lord, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved: for thou art my praise.

Isaiah 41:10 (CWSB) 10 Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.

Isaiah 43:1-2 (CWSB) 1 But now thus saith the Lord that created thee, O Jacob, and he that formed thee, O Israel, Fear not: for I have redeemed thee, I have called thee by thy name; thou art mine. 2 When thou passest through the waters, I will be with thee; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow thee: when thou walkest through the fire, thou shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee.
