

Bishop Forin D. Newsome, 11:00 a.m. Speaker



Bishop Torin Newsome is a native of Oakland, California. He learned to love the Lord at an early age and joined the Greater New Mt. Hermon MBC at 3 years old. His Godfather and mentor was Pastor Reverend Nelson Davis. He graduated from Skyline High School in Oakland and studied at Concordia University. He is happily married to Lady Carla Brown Newsome.

The Citadel of Praise Baptist Church was founded on February 24, 2013, in Berkeley, California.

In 2017, Pastor Newsome and his ministry team established churches in Nairobi, and Kissi, Africa where the Pastors of each of these sister churches were installed under the umbrella of Citadel of Praise, Oakland. Also in 2017, the Citadel of Praise Orphanage in Kenya was established which serves over 50 children who have become orphans through AIDS and other diseases that are prevalent on the continent. We also took on a sister church in Kakinada, India.

On May 6, 2019, with the help of God, the Board treasurer and the Pastor, and the membership, the members of Citadel of Praise caravanned to our newly purchased current location at 1850 15th Street, San Pablo, California.

Bishop Gregory Bernard Payton is held as one of the premiere pastors and voices in ministry today. He was raised in the historic St. John Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of the late organizer, Dr. C. J. Anderson.

On October 1, 2004, Greater St. John Missionary Baptist Church presented Reverend Gregory B. Payton as the second Pastor of the historic church. He has truly transitioned Greater St. John to higher heights. Under the leadership of Bishop Payton, Greater St. John Missionary Baptist Church has implemented many new ministries and enhanced several existing ministries. He currently holds the office of President of the California Missionary Baptist State Congress on Christian Education.

In December of 2016, he was elevated to the office of Bishop, which took place in an official Bishop Consecration Service held at the Evergreen Missionary Baptist Church of Oakland, California. In January, 2025, he celebrated nineteen years as Pastor of the Greater St. John Missionary Baptist Church of Oakland California. Bishop Payton is a humble under-shepherd and a dynamic orator. Being a motivator, advisor, administrator, businessman, lecturer, revivalist, coach, mentor, teacher, father, grandfather, visionary, pastor and so much more, he has truly made a lasting impression and continues to do so for his parishioners, family, community and for future generations to come.
