As a freshman in high school I made the basketball team as a substitute. All that means is a lot of practice, but rarely actual play time...until that one fateful night when our home gym was filled with rabid fans. Only a few seconds remained in the game and we were trailing by one point; I couldn't believe my ears! The coach looked all the way down to the end of the bench and yelled for me to go in because our last player had fouled out. Unbelievably excited, I ran onto the court, promptly received a pass, and with an immediate jump shot scored what surely would be the winning shot. As I celebrated with my hands in the air, I heard the coach yell, "Get back on defense!" With my hands still in the air I saw the ball pass right over the top of my head to an opposing player who ran past me. He received the pass and scored the game winning layup. Such a sad memory of my first game, but it was a memory full of life lessons.

The past four years have been full of victories for unborn children in our state and our nation. With the passing of Yes on I in November of 2014 came an open door for informed consent for women and girls considering abortion, inspection or regulation of abortion facilities, and hospitalization requirement for late term abortions. This, along with the closing of many abortion clinics and the appointment of two conservative Supreme Court justices, we who are prolife can raise our hands and celebrate! But

we must never forget that we who are the defenders of unborn children have opponents who will take advantage of any laxness on our part. If we aren't constantly vigilant, they will catch us with our guard down and sprint to their goal of financial gain at the expense of precious lives of unborn children.

This is one of the big reasons why the Birth Choice Board of Directors and the leadership staff at Birth Choice have taken steps to add on a mobile medical unit within the first three months of next year. This unit will enable us to reach even more women who are considering abortion, especially in outlying areas. This undertaking is huge given the amount of money it will require to purchase the unit (\$155,000) and the yearly expense to keep it going (\$35,000). However, we firmly believe that we at Birth Choice are not the substitute players seated at the end of the bench, but rather the front line participants to save lives. As supporters of this ministry, so are you! And this is certainly not a game; it is a deadly serious reality.

As believers, we know for certain that you and I are called to stand in the gap for the unborn. WE MUST DO ALL WE CAN TO SAVE ONE MORE LIFE BECAUSE GOD MADE THEM ALL - FEARFULLY, WONDERFULLY, AND IN HIS IMAGE.

- ⁶⁶I had already decided to parent, though the ultrasound was still a beautiful thing to see. The environment and the people are wonderful and caring. ⁵⁵


JACKSON CLINIC NEEDS




