Many of you have probably heard the disturbing news of the remains of over 2,200 aborted babies found in the home and in the trunks of cars belonging to Dr. Ulrich Klopfer. Klopher was an Indiana abortionist who passed away this past September. Klopfer will join another abortionist, Kermit Gosnell, as history's most prolific serial killers in the United States. Gosnell began serving a life sentence without parole in 2013 after being convicted of first degree murder for snipping the spinal cords of three babies born alive during his abortions. He also was convicted of one count of manslaughter for allowing a woman to die in his abortion clinic. The remains of scores of aborted fetuses were found in various containers all over his clinic. Many of those aborted babies were big enough to have survived outside of the womb. The reason both Gosnell and Klopher kept the remains of many of the children they aborted is indicative of what serial killers do. They keep some kind of mementos of their victims as "trophies".

At Birth Choice we have trophies, too, but nothing like the horrible ones those abortionists left behind. We use 'DIAMONDS' to represent each precious child saved from abortion when their mothers change their minds and choose life. We place those 'diamond trophies' one by one into a jar and throughout the year our diamond count grows and grows. So far this year we have 110 diamonds in the jar pictured here! Each of those diamonds in the jar represents a baby saved from abortion. Four extra diamonds went into the jar because to date, we have four sets of twins saved from abortion! That total number will continue to grow by the end of the year."



Instead of trophies of death, our diamonds are trophies of LIFE. Instead of trophies of pain, we collect trophies of JOY. In place of brokenness, our diamonds represent HEALING. Instead of regret those diamonds represent HOPE. Our diamond trophies represent the future that awaits each tiny person whom God Himself created.


