Pentecost—Sunday, May 19, 2024



Pentecost is the climax of the fifty-days of Easter. It celebrates the gift of the Holy Spirit to the body of Christ – the church – to empower its members to be witnesses to the resurrection in word and deed.

The Holy Spirit breaks us out of our preoccupation with ourselves and frees us to serve neighbors. It loosens our grasp on possessions and sets us to love others. On this day the power of the Holy Spirit appeared to Jesus' followers as the rush of a mighty wind and tongues of fire and they spoke

in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability (Acts 2.1-4). To commemorate this day, the birthday of the church, wear something red. This is a symbol for the tongues of fire of the Holy Spirit.
