

WOW Bolinas Point Loop Trail Saturday August 17, 2024

Escape our relentless summer heat for a day on the coast. WOWers will hike the 2.5-mile loop trail near Bolinas, CA, part of the Point Reyes National Seashore. Lupe Zendejas is our leader for the hike and has scouted it out for us. The trail is a very nice stroll through meadows and along the bluffs with great ocean views up and down the coast, and has a little bit of history. If you do the loop in a clockwise

direction, it leads across cow pastures to a clifftop view of the ocean, and then runs along the cliffs for a ways to reach the decaying ruins of a huge building that back in 1912 was a telegraph relay station. Windy conditions are common near the ocean. Watch for poison oak along the trail edges and off the trail. The trail is clean.

There are no restrooms at the trailhead.

Hikers will meet at the Woodland Presbyterian Church parking lot at 8:00 a.m. to sign in, receive instructions for the day, and form carpools. We will leave at 8:15 for the 2-hour drive.

Hikers should bring lunch, water, sunscreen, and layered clothing. This hike is dog friendly. Dogs must be kept on a leash. After the hike, explore Bolinas, have lunch or refreshments there, consider a second hike. There are many trails nearby. Chill (literally) and soak in the cool weather.
