Recovery (Mitigation)	<p>Oct. 6- Nov. 4</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• We entered into contract with Serve Pro to mitigate the damage post Hurricane Ian• Their work included removing water, the damaged carpet, sheetrock 4’ up on interior walls and drying out the entire area• Mold was removed and the property treated• Insurance adjusters have been onsite to assess damage firsthand. <p>The process provides time for us to continue to assess damage that was not immediately evident.</p>
Remediation	<p>Oct. 6- Nov. 4</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• FEMA has been contacted.• The Diocese has given us two checks totaling \$10,000, and we have received a check for \$250,000 from Church Insurance to help pay contractors throughout the process. <p>FEMA requires a great deal of documentation. If you have pictures of the church property before, during or after IAN that you think may be helpful, please forward them to Lynn at the Church office.</p>
Restoration And Revisioning	<p>Weekly Meetings</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fr. Joe established Revisioning and Renovation Team that meets weekly, Mondays at 1pm, to discern the leading of God for the GS property offering creative suggestions for repurposing and improving our space consistent with our mission and purpose.• They are working through the many details, with Diocese support, to make recommendations for the renovation and <i>rebuilding</i> phase. <p>This team will be forming subcommittees to consider specific areas/spaces for revisioning.</p>
Rebuilding	<p>Currently, there is no timeline for renovation to begin. We’ve been told, “This is a marathon, not a sprint”, to which we have agreed to work as quickly as possible, as slow as necessary!</p>
