The time is fast approaching for our 104th Session of the East Zion Consolidated District Congress of Christian Education, scheduled for July 15—17, 2024. This year’s Session will be hosted by the Paradise Baptist Church, where I serve as Pastor, and Northeast Baptist Church, Rev. Michael McDaniel, Pastor.

As Congress President, I am excited about the upcoming gathering of our Pastors and churches for a time of learning and fellowship. Dean Lavinnie Moore, along with the staff and instructors, have been preparing for and anticipating your participation.

Included in this packet is the schedule of classes that will be taught during the session, the school schedule and other information. You will see that we have a Mid-Day Class that will meet onsite. All other classes will be held nightly (Monday—Wednesday) from 6-7:45pm. We will again have with us, the Rev. Moses Gordon III of New Orleans, LA, who will bring the message during our Worship Period on the 15th and 16th.

Since we have shortened the session to three days, the Dean’s and President’s Addresses will be on the evening of the 17th. This is Sister Moore’s last year as our Dean and we want to support her well on that night and show appreciation for the years of service she has rendered to this District. She has led well and is worthy of recognition for all that has been accomplished during her tenure.

This year, Moderator Booker has begun a new program for our member churches. If your church is participating in the EZCDA Unified Budget and have paid at least half by the Congress date, you can register as many members as you like for the classes. There is no limit for you and your church. If your church is not a participant, the cost per member will be \$25 per person for adults and \$10 for youth. This new method is a great savings and incentive for you and your membership] to attend. Pastors are still asked to register with \$50.

We will again have Virtual as well as In-Person classes. We ask that you encourage your Christian Education leader to pre-register those that will be attending. Your cooperation is needed to aid the instructors and staff in preparing for a successful learning experience. Pre-registration is open and is being conducted through the District website, www.eastziondistrict.org, until July 14. As of July 15, registration must be completed onsite.
