

GREETINGS FROM THE CAPITAL CAMPAIGN TEAM

Dear members of Atonement Lutheran Church,

We, the members of the Growing the Seeds of Faith Capital Campaign team are beyond grateful for your support of the campaign effort and your generous giving to support the goals that we established at the outset of this process. We have made wonderful progress toward retiring our mortgage. Maybe more importantly, we have made our presence felt in the greater Billings Community by the generous support of our community tithe recipients and we have grown our own ministry team by funding of our Youth and Family Minister with Capital Campaign giving.

Throughout the duration of this campaign, the outstanding mortgage balance has been reduced from \$1.193 million to \$695,424 as of August 31, 2023 – certainly more reduction to come in these closing months. In addition, Atonement has donated a total of \$30,900 to Family Promise, Christikon, and Friendship House – more to come here in the closing months of the campaign as well. Finally, as stated above, this capital campaign has funded the YFM position for four years; a "savings" of approximately \$100,000 from the General Fund. These are amazing accomplishments of which everyone should be proud.

As discussed at the last Annual Meeting, this capital campaign will close at the end of this year. You have shared your generosity for the duration of this campaign even when we struggled with change and uncertainty as we worked our way through a pandemic and an extended interim time without a pastor. In a few months when the campaign closes, we hope that you can continue to share this generosity and help our church continue to grow its ministries. The council, finance and stewardship teams will be sharing information about transitioning the funding of our Youth and Family Minister to the general fund. Please keep this in mind as you consider your stewardship pledges and how you might distribute your financial contributions to our general fund and mortgage reduction/building fund.

And again, thank you, thank you, thank you!!
