Dear Parishioners of St. John Ev. Lutheran Church,

Thank you for your generous contribution to the Spencer Chamber Foundation Flood Recovery Fund. Every gift we receive has a meaningful impact, and your support of \$750.50 on 12/13/2024 is deeply appreciated.

The flood disaster that struck Spencer and Clay County, Iowa, nearly six months ago, on June 22, 2024, caused widespread devastation. However, thanks to the overwhelming generosity of over 350 donors like you, the Chamber Foundation has been able to award grants to 51 businesses and 217 residents throughout Clay County through the Spencer Chamber Foundation Disaster Recovery Fund. In Spencer alone, floodwaters affected over 2,100 properties and approximately 100 houses have collapsed basement wall(s) as well as other severe damage. For the many blessings that come from Heaven above; we thank you, Lord, with heart and soul and sing of Your great love!


