Matthew 5:14-16

<sup>14</sup> “You are the light of the world. A city built on a hill cannot be hid. <sup>15</sup> People do not light a lamp and put it under the bushel basket; rather, they put it on the lampstand, and it gives light to all in the house. <sup>16</sup> In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven.

As we begin the journey together through this Lenten season, let us remember the call to be light of the world. God’s gift of love and grace revealed to us in Jesus Christ inspires us to serve and care for those around us. St John Lutheran Church is Christ’s church, and it sits upon the hill in Charles City as a testament to the light that shines through us.

During this time of intentional reflection, look around and see your neighbors, your coworkers, your friends and family. Look for the need in places you wouldn’t normally pay attention to. Where is there suffering? Where is there a need for resistance? Where can we stand and speak in advocacy for another? Where can we be of assistance? Maybe it all just feels too overwhelming. Maybe you already feel as if you have all that you can handle on your plate right now. Remember when it feels like too much, God is there. Now is the time, to bring those feelings to God in prayer. God always finds a way where we cannot perceive a way. When you see the hurt and hurting in the world ask God what you can do to be a helper. It might look like finding ways to engage in service and outreach, or volunteering and supporting ministries here at St John, or it might look like simply being a presence of kindness and encouragement to someone who just needs someone to take the time to listen. Whatever direction God points you in, help with what you can, as you can. Don’t hide the light and love that you have been given but let it shine as a beacon of hope witnessing to God’s love in action.

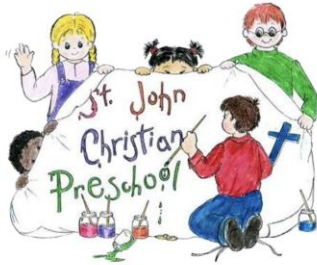
We need volunteers to sign up to bring treats. There is a sign-up sheet by the Narthex doors.

We will be running our All-School Fundraiser in the month of April, so be on the lookout for more information about that coming soon! 😊

We have loved having the privilege of getting to know our many friends and their amazing families this school year, but it is already time to start thinking about registration for the fall semester and welcoming some new families to our preschool program. Please feel free to pass on the following information to anyone who may be interested.

Our registration began on Monday, January 27, for our families who were *currently* enrolled. Registration for *new* families was held at our Registration Open House on Thursday, February 6. Registration will continue until all our classes are full. Families who have a child who will be at least 3 on or before September 15 can register for our morning class. That 3-day class meets Monday-Wednesday-Friday mornings from 8:30-11:30 a.m. Families who have a child who will be at least 4 on or before September 15 can register for one of our two afternoon classes. The 4-day session meets Monday-Tuesday-Thursday-Friday from 12:30-3:30 p.m. (Statewide Voluntary Preschool Program and is FREE) and the 5-day session meets EVERY day from 12:30-3:30 pm but will let out at 2:30pm on Wednesdays, as to coincide with the district's early out day. A \$30 non-refundable registration fee is due at the time of registration. Families may choose to pay \$50 for the entire year or \$30 per semester.
