

Bear and Deloris was asked by Bishop Kelly Lineberry in January 2023 to consider Pastoring the Church in Doty. They visited the church at the end of February. The current Pastors were retiring and leaving the following week. Much to their surprise the church members voted to have them become the new pastors. March 5th, they Began to be the senior Pastors. Bear and Deloris met serving in ministry in Tennessee. Bear was raised in a Lutheran Church in Ohio, but never served God and made a mess of his life. With a broken life at age 27 He moved to Tampa Fla where he started attending Church, asked Christ into his heart and had a complete life change when born again. He became a licensed and Ordained Minister in 1980. He started and pioneered a small church in Florida, later moving to Tennessee where he met the love of his life and married Maysie Deloris Yawn in 1985. They have served together in ministry ever since. Deloris was raised in the Mississippi Delta in a loving Christian family. Her dad was an evangelist. She gave her heart to the Lord at a young age and served with her Daddy in ministry, accompanying him on piano as she now does with Pastor Bear. Bear has been a Senior Pastor for 20 years, Associate Pastor for 7 years, Youth Leader and Youth Department Director 2 years. For years he did evangelism, working extensively with Tent Ministries. He also served in a Christian School ministry with Deloris where they met. In 1990 Bear and Deloris moved to Orofino Idaho where they became part of the PCG. Eventually becoming senior pastors. Having previous experience, they Started and administrated a much needed and successful Christian School for 8 years. In 2014 They Resigned to help with family in Mississippi. 3 years later they returned to Idaho and are now serving in Doty, Washington. The Church in Doty is doing extremely well because of the congregation and their love for each other. The church has two services per week and uses a number of different methods for outreach. Pastor Bear says his wife is such an incredible Godly example and loving Pastor to the ladies. Bear and Deloris have always had a servant's heart and have always served wherever they go.


