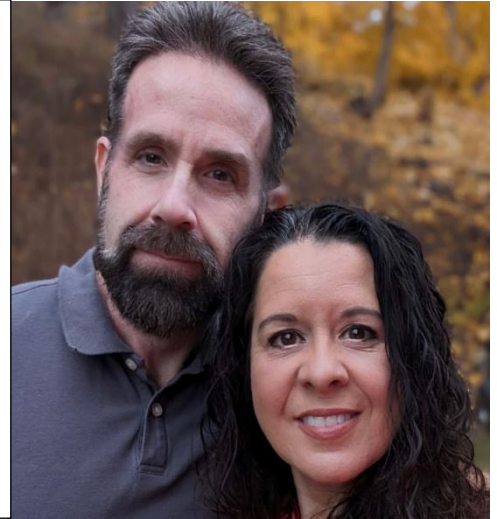

From the Bishop's Desk.

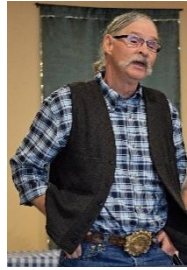

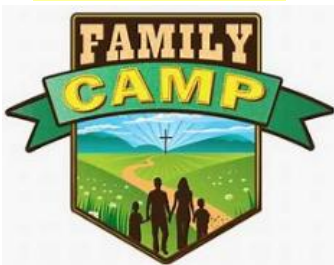

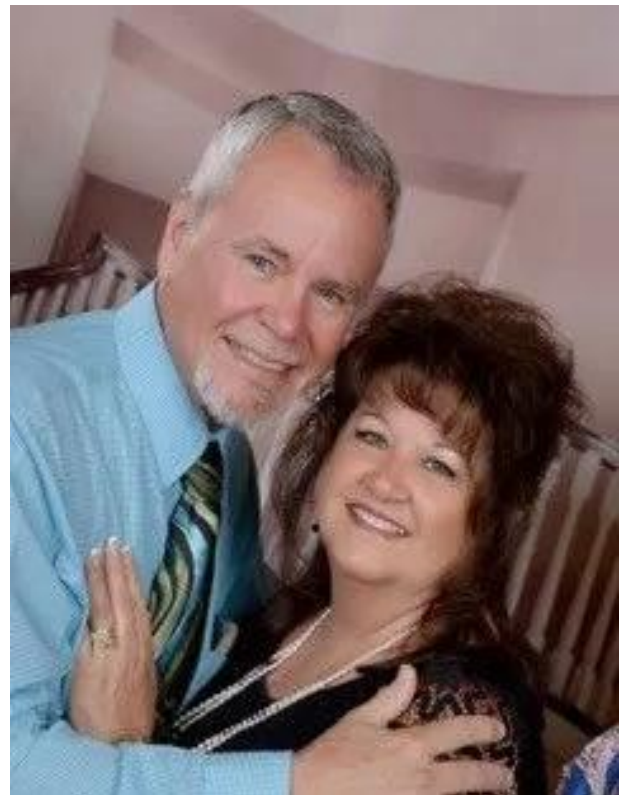
