Jamie & Clarise Joiner have worked in PNWPCG for many years. Saved under Bro. McCarty at Cardiff Spur in the mid-70's. They began working in their local church ministering, then working in Youth Camps. They pastored in Brewster, Wa for a season, then voted in as District PYPA Presidents 1982-1985 (Youth Leaders). Served on District board for many years and as District Presbyterian and District Bishop for several years. Jamie also served as an assistant general to the National Bishop. Clarise worked as Women's Ministry Director and cooked many youth camps. They have showed a true heart of serving and continue to do so in Pierce, ID.

Jamie and Clarise are now enjoying pastoring in their Senior years at an awesome little independent church in Pierce Idaho. New Life Fellowship is a small country church with people attending from all walks of life. We have witnessed miracles of people who have been saved and healed and delivered just by attending, and later sharing that when they walked through the door they felt so much love, and God set them free then in there, without any of us even knowing it at the time. This has happened on several occasions with salvations and healings, one lady a Meth addict for more than 25 years instantly set free when she walked in the door. God has uniquely welded this body of believers together for a mountain top Revival, with his love and a heart to serve their community in a big way. Big Events are planned throughout the year where they serve the community with thousands of dollars of commodities, no strings attached, whether it be huge dinners, BBQ's, school supply give away, sponsoring any kid on this mountain top to youth camp that wants to go, Game Nights, and much more. Besides supporting their Pastors full time and paying about 7 other people on staff, they support 14 different missionaries and students to Bible Colleges with an amount of \$250.00 each month apiece. Our vision is not attending church, which we could never get them all in there anyway, but it's "Doing Life Together," and we do. We have three independent youth services, two different woman's Bible studies, weekly, Men's fellowship breakfast weekly, and Home Groups Weekly also. We have Side by Side Rides regularly, a Men's Retreat on the North Fork of the Clearwater, Cowboy Church during Weippe's Rodeo and Prospector's Church during Pierces 1860 Days, and all kinds of get togethers constantly. We purchased a Bouncy House and set it up several times a year for events, and we never charge or take offerings for any of these events. We don't just attend church, we do life together. There is so much more we could share, but we want to pause and just give Jesus all the glory for a very unique church where he has hand-picked the congregation, and almost weekly new people are connecting with New Life. We've lost count of salvations, in the crowd during closing prayers.

We thank Jesus to just get to be a part of what he is doing and serve these awesome people on this mountain top. We really feel pretty insignificant in the big picture. They just love us and take care of us like they do the rest of this mountain top. You would have to experience it to really understand what it is, God is Amazing, and so faithful.



## What is Family Camp?

Glad you asked! Family Camp is a time where our PNW (Pacific Northwest) family comes together. We will have great fellowship centered around anointed services. The evenings will have a full service in the sanctuary followed by fellowship in the Family Room or around the outdoor fire pit. Coffee will be served in the morning (Tuesday - Thursday), a lunch will be provided and served outdoors Tuesday - Thursday, and a dinner will be provided Tuesday - Thursday also served outdoor picnic style. Old time camp meeting style preaching each evening Monday - Thursday and a short teaching session Tuesday - Thursday. 



