
Fred Kerley is doing so much better. He looks good and is getting around well. Still has to take it slow and easy, but continues to improve. PTL

Arby Shown is the Senior Pastor at The Life Center in Kamiah, Idaho. He, along with his wife Kathleen, have a heart for their native Clearwater Valley and have spent their lives ministering to their hometown crowd. The Shown's have three children and recently added a daughter-in-law to the mix.

Shown was inspired to pastor as a young man after being a guide on a mountain lion hunt on the St. Joe River in the middle of a snowstorm. Still about 14 miles from his truck, Shown was walking out of the woods when he heard a clear voice in his spirit from God, "Will you come teach for me?" Arby knelt down in the snow, wept, and said, "yes." Shown's ministry began with leading a youth group in Lapwai, ID, before being asked to be the Youth Pastor at The Life Center in Kamiah. Shown served as the Youth Pastor and then the Associate Pastor under Kelly Lineberry for 14 years before being asked to be the Senior Pastor, a role he has had for the last 8 years.

Shown has served as a PNW Board Member. He is a member of the Upper Clearwater Ministerial Association and serves as the host for Open Gym Nights for the and adults in the Clearwater Valley. Shown also plays on a co-ed softball team and is a baseball coach at the local high school.

During the COVID shutdowns, Shown noticed that there were over 2000 people watching his messages online. Because of this, The Life Center continues to stream their live Sunday morning service with consistent attendance online. Shown has a relaxed ministerial style, wearing shorts and a ballcap even from the pulpit. He believes that everyone should feel at home at The Life Center. This informal style and Arby and Kathleen's desire to form lasting positive relationships, has helped them continue to serve their community, while also strengthening their walk with God as they learn and grow together. 
