Fred Kerley continues to get stronger. Continue to pray.

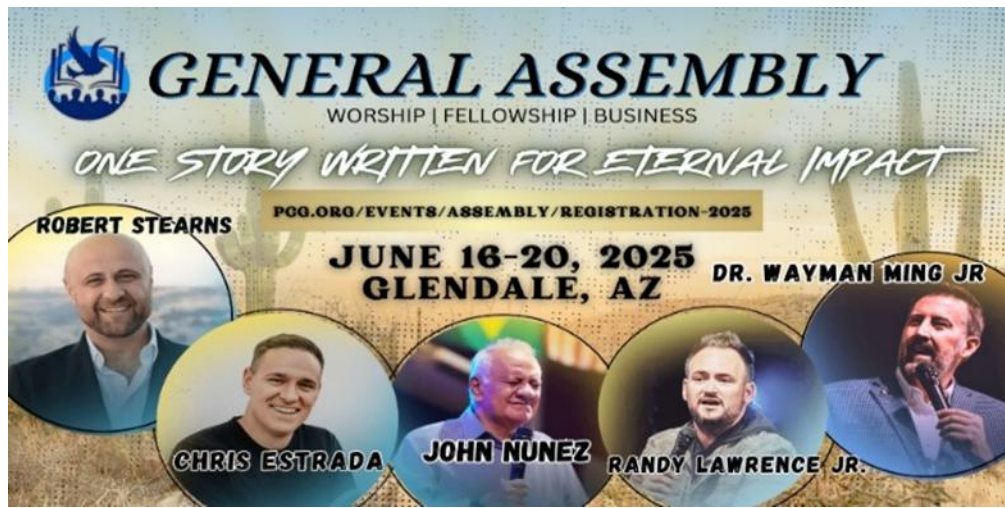

Glad you asked! Family Camp is a time where our PNW (Pacific Northwest) family comes together. We will have great fellowship centered around anointed services. The evenings will have a full service in the sanctuary followed by fellowship in the Family Room or around the outdoor fire pit. Coffee will be served in the morning (Tuesday - Thursday), a lunch will be provided and served outdoors Tuesday - Thursday, and a dinner will be provided Tuesday - Thursday also served outdoor picnic style.
