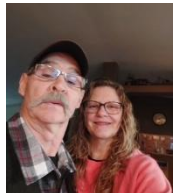

Glad you asked! Family Camp is a time where our PNW (Pacific Northwest) family comes together. We will have great fellowship centered around anointed services. The evenings will have a full service in the sanctuary followed by fellowship in the Family Room or around the outdoor fire pit. Coffee will be served in the morning (Tuesday - Thursday), a lunch will be provided and served outdoors Tuesday - Thursday, and a dinner will be provided Tuesday - Thursday also served outdoor picnic style. Old time camp meeting style preaching each evening Monday - Thursday and a short teaching session Tuesday - Thursday. From the Bishop's Desk.

Happy 4th of July!

A few years ago, I had the privilege of being Chaplain to John Alden, a direct descendent (13 generations) of the Mayflower pilgrims, John Alden was one of the 42 men who signed the Mayflower Compact, one sentence describes part of their purpose, mission, **cause**...

“Having undertaken for the Glory of God, and **Advancement of the Christian Faith**, and the Honor of our King and Country, a Voyage to plant the first Colony in the northern Parts of Virginia; Do by these Presents, solemnly and mutually, in the Presence of God and one another, covenant and combine ourselves together into a civil Body Politick.”

And 156 years later their descendants penned in the Declaration of Independence...

“We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights, that among these are Life, Liberty, and the pursuit of Happiness”. And less than 100 year later Abraham Lincoln delivered his famous Gettysburg Address...

Four score and seven years ago our fathers brought forth on this continent a new nation, conceived in liberty, and dedicated to the proposition that all men are created equal.

What will history record of us?

We have a mandate, there is no plan B, this mandate is for every church, and every believer! We are all called to fulfill this mission. One Mission, One Movement!

Mark 16.15-18 And He said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned. And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.”

Matthew 28.18-20 And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, “All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and **make disciples** of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.” Amen.

1 Kings 8.54-61 Solomon Blesses the Assembly - And so it was, when Solomon had finished praying all this prayer and supplication to the LORD, that he arose from before the altar of the LORD, from kneeling on his knees with his hands spread up to heaven. Then he stood and blessed all the assembly of Israel with a loud voice, saying: “Blessed be the LORD, who has given rest to His people Israel, according to all that He promised. There has not failed one word of all His good promise, which He promised through His servant Moses. May the LORD our God be with us, as He was with our fathers. May He not leave us nor forsake us, that He may incline our hearts to Himself, to walk in all His ways, and to keep His commandments and His statutes and His judgments, which He commanded our fathers. And may these words of mine, with which I have made supplication before the LORD, be near the LORD our God day and night, that He may maintain **the cause** of His servant and **the cause** of His people Israel, as each day may require, **that all the peoples of the earth may know that the LORD is God; there is no other**. Let your heart therefore be loyal to the LORD our God, to walk in His statutes and keep His commandments, as at this day.”

Solomon prayed that God would not leave nor forsake them, and that He would incline our hearts to keep His commandments, statutes, and judgments. That He would maintain **the cause** so the world may know that the Lord is God and there is no other! That's it right there, our main cause and purpose is that **the world may know God and that there is no other**, no other way! This is our primary focus, may we stay laser pointed to make disciples that make disciples! May our hearts be loyal to the Lord and **the cause**! We must rely upon Him to maintain **the cause**! God sent Holy Spirit to maintain **the cause**, Jesus said "tarry ye in Jerusalem until ye be endured with power from on high", and in Acts 1.8 But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

That all the peoples of the earth may know...

Know - Hebrew Yada, Greek-

Ginosko. Intimately, progressively, and effectually. Discipleship is relational (intimate), time (progressive), change (effectual)! Becoming like Jesus! May we build true relationships taking the time to invest meaningful change in people's lives, a metamorphosis if you will! Romans 8.2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God. Amen!
