September we are featuring our Pastor of Living Water, Yakima, WA.

Vicki Munson



Vicki's roots in Pentecost are life-long. She was born the middle of 5 children to a Pentecostal pastor and his wife. At the age of 5 she had a profound experience with the Lord that cemented her relationship with Jesus for life. At the age of 18 she was filled with the Holy Spirit with the evidence of speaking in tongues. The joy of the Lord has been her strength for all these years.

The journey to pastoring at Living Water Church has been a long one filled with the blessing and provision of God. In her teens she learned to play the guitar and piano and developed a love for music. Throughout her life she has played and sang on many worship teams in various churches. She also performed solo and with quartets. There is nothing like the anointing that flows through music. At Living Water she leads music that is blended with prayer and yields to the leading of the Holy Spirit.

Vicki had a love for the Bible that became more acute in her 20's. She studied in her private time and was always finding anointed ministry to mentor under. So at Living Water the Word takes first place. She enjoys preaching the Word but also loves teaching and discussion.

Vicki's roots in PCG run back to her father who pioneered the first church at 808 W Mead Ave. when she was 4 years old. He later started New Hope Chapel in Yakima. After his death her mother remarried and pastored New Hope Chapel for 25 years with Rev James Layne. Both men had a profound effect on her love of God and ministry. The founding of Living Water Church was something Vicki did not anticipate but God opened the door and she said "Yes Lord". The church was named because of a desire to see the Living Water of the Gospel to flow through the Yakima Valley. A place where the Holy Spirit can move as he chooses.

Vicki has 3 daughters and 2 grandsons that are the joy of her life.

September is IMPACT ETERNITY month!

Each one, reach one!

1. Every person sharing their faith.
2. Every church doing an outreach.
3. Every Nation touching major cities.

START MAKING A PLAN

Some practical examples of how others are sharing Christ include...

One on one – First, be a friend. Share the story about how Jesus changed your life. Invite them to your home, a café, or another public meeting space.

In small groups – Meet with friends at a home, on the street, in the marketplace, or in a park.

Using your gifts – However God has gifted you, bless others with that gift (sewing, reading a book, a craft, telling a story).

Online / Digital – Text or call someone from your contact list. Just let them know you were thinking about them or offer to pray with them. Consider hosting a virtual Bible study or sharing a Bible story on social media. Try live streaming a concert from your church or even from your home.

At the local church – Host a back-to-school bash or family fun event on campus. Or get outside the four walls to volunteer at a shelter or food pantry.

More ideas include leaving notes for your postmen, sanitation workers, etc. Simply let our civil servants know that you appreciate them and are praying for them. And above all, pray for your community. Now **GO and “make disciples of all nations” (Matt. 28:19)!**

Your story is the best tool you have to spread the Good News of Jesus Christ. It is personal, it is real, and it is the thing you know the most about—your own experience with God.

Jesus' last words on earth were very clear: “Go into all the world and preach the Gospel to all creation” (Mk. 16:15). Unfortunately, some have taken this statement as a suggestion rather than a command. Believe it or not, through the power of the Spirit, we are ALL called to be witnesses.

So what can YOU do to share the Gospel? All you need is a willingness to go and use your gifts as the Lord leads you. There are countless ways to do this, either on your own or with a group or church.

Matthew 9:35-38 (AMP) 35 And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the good news (the Gospel) of the kingdom and curing all kinds of disease and every weakness and infirmity.

36 When He saw the throngs, He was moved with pity and sympathy for them, because they were bewildered (harassed and distressed and dejected and helpless), like sheep without a shepherd.

38 So pray to the Lord of the harvest to force out and thrust laborers into His harvest.
