Continue praying for Steve Umphenour. Going through another round of Chemo.

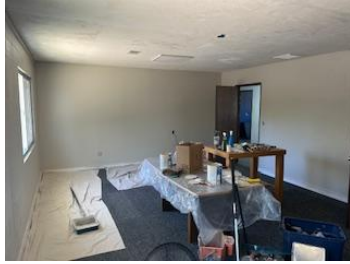
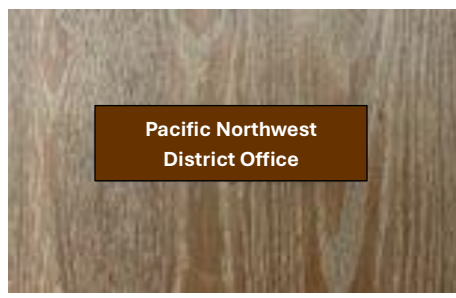
Please continue to pray for Pastor Arby Shown. Recovering from severe concussion and needs prayer for continued healing.

From the Bishop's Desk,

Happy 250th 4th of July! As Lee Greenwood aptly sings "I'm proud to be an American"! I'm very thankful for my Country and our Christian heritage in the United States of America. I strongly urge everyone to connect with David Barton of Wall builders, he is the best when it comes to U.S. history. There are so many rewriting history and well-meaning people react to such not knowing that they are following something that is not well-documented and that is untrue. My favorite book by David and Tim Barton is: The American Story: The Beginnings (Vol. 1): Focuses on the founding era, early pioneers, and the influence of religious and civil freedom. Enjoyable and so valuable at this crucial time in our history.

Family Camp was simply amazing! Services were wonderful as we experienced God's hand upon us for this great work that is set before us! Thank you to everyone who came and participated in the 'working' Family Camp. EVERYONE worked so hard. Much was accomplished, we filled another 30-yard dumpster with garbage, tear-out material from demolished walls, carpet removal, outside debris, and more! It's being transformed and New Hope is on the rise, both physically and spiritually. With walls removed the new entry will accommodate for many more people, the old nursery is becoming a coffee bar, another room is designated for the new nursery. The ladies of the PNW painted a room that will be used by our District Board 4 times a year, it looks beautiful and has already been used! The new District Office received its name plate this trip along with office supplies, it is ready for use. Pastor Roby Roberson put the finishing touches upon our new office by installing the outside window trim, now it's ready for the paint! Our Board moved to completely update an old antiquated electrical system and will be completed in July! PTL, it previously was a great fire hazard which will soon be eliminated. A new state of the art HVAC system has been installed in the east half of the church facility (our insurance covered this loss from last winter, a \$40,000.00 system installed and completely supplied, PTL). Pastor Bear Harvey worked so hard at preparing the wall that will receive beautiful 7' double glass doors at the East exit, they will so accent that east exit/entry, wow, it's gonna pop! There is yet much work to be done so there will be future work days to be scheduled, so if you missed this one, don't worry, we got you covered! Upcoming projects is drywall repair and replacement in various places of facility, plank flooring installation, Sanctuary carpet installation, electrical needs (can-lights installed), landscaping, concrete sidewalks, parking lot and kitchen renovation! Everyone has opportunity to participate in this great restoration, all of this points to souls being added to the Kingdom of God. Soon we will have information available where you can donate for certain projects, already people are purchasing X amount of square footage for the new Sanctuary carpet! Others are purchasing paint, a brother has already offered to paint inside and outside for a cup of coffee! Extra-large cup! We need gravel for the new parking lot, machinery and operator for grading the new lot, concrete finishers, dry-wallers, electricians for can-light installation (entry-way).

Services will begin soon! Already neighbors are expressing their gratitude for this much needed renovation! One young man said “the Lord told me to do this” and handed Bishop an envelope that contained 30 \$100.00 bills! He said “I want this to go to New Hope”!

A special thank you to Pastor Jamie Joiner and Pastor Dan Rogers for bringing a ‘right now’ word to us! As Bishop, I’m so privileged to serve alongside great ministers of this caliber!

Now is the time to register for AIM, August 6 is the deadline for Fall registration, currently we have possibly 10 registering, PTL! Not only is New Hope on the rise but the PNW is on the rise. DEAN BRAZLE'S 100TH BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION

In a remarkable alignment of milestones, North County is home to WWII Centenarian Seabee Dean Junior Brazle. Born on July 4, 1926, Dean's 100th birthday aligns perfectly with the nation's 250th. Dean isn't just a local veteran; he's a living piece of history. As a U.S. Navy Seabee from 1944 to 1946, he was a critical "worker bee" in the Pacific, building the bases that made the "Island Hopping" strategy possible. After his time in the service, he operated a 640-acre ranch near Bonaparte Mountain and remains a pillar of the Oroville community today.

From AIM Director-John Oebel:

AIM is the Accelerated Institute of Ministry and was started in 1999 by the vision of Dr. Phil Redding in the PCG Arkansas District. It began as an opportunity for people seeking ministerial license with the Pentecostal Church of God and quickly expanded to include laity from different denominations. While all of the minister's series is included in the curriculum numerous elective courses have been offered such as Youth Ministry, The Pastor's Wife, The Trinity, Eternal Security, Bible Prophecy, Music in the Church, Training for Ministerial Chaplaincy, Crisis Counseling, etc. Each year dozens of students graduate at the Arkansas District Convention in a Friday night ceremony in one-, two-, three-and four-year certificate programs.

This year we are joining AIM to bring outstanding bible teaching to Pacific Northwest District. Classes will be hosted by several host churches in PNW and will be telecasted by satellite from Arkansas.

Classes will be the second Saturday of each month starting September 12 from 7:30 am PST to 1:00 pm PST. With a break after the first class with some kind of refreshment provided by the host church.

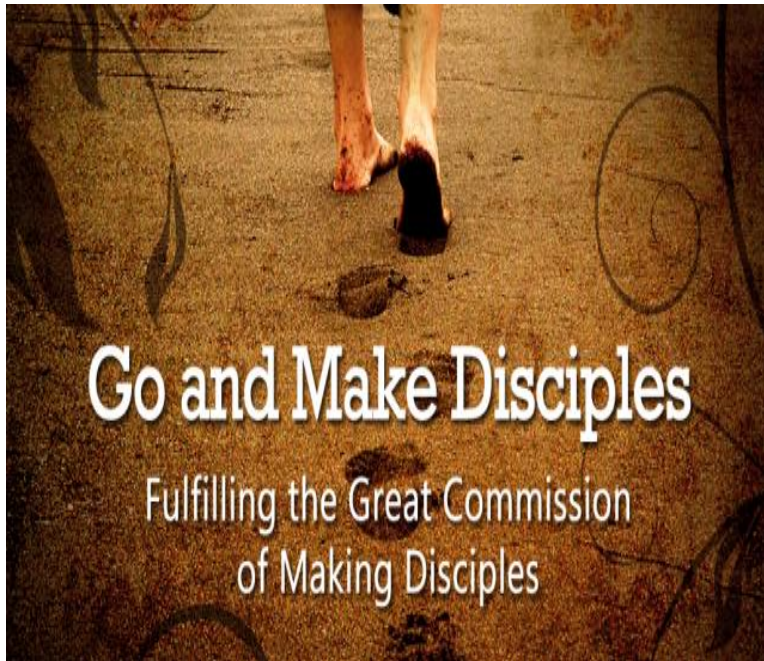
