Greetings,

Now that Thanksgiving is behind us, a new focus is on Christmas, but the world's version of Christmas is stress and things. However, if we follow the Church we will enjoy the beauty of the season of Advent which gives a proper focus to the birth of Christ. It is the beginning of the Christian calendar where we give 24 days to prayer and preparation for the birth of Jesus, the Word Incarnate. With that in mind, beginning December 2nd, the first day of Advent, St. Anthony parishioners are invited to begin praying the Angelus each day at noon as a church family. The bells at the church ring at noon to remind everyone to stop their daily tasks and take a moment to pray and thank the Lord. The school will also stop for the noon reminder to pray the Angelus. This was done years ago and all who participated remember the tradition with joy and favor. To help in this daily practice of praying the Angelus, I would encourage you to utilize the new St. Anthony App and set a reminder to pray where ever you are. You can find the Angelus prayer in the prayer icon, and reminders are located at the bottom of the page--It's pretty neat.

In addition to praying the Angelus, there will be daily Advent reflections posted each day in the St. Anthony App and in Facebook. You can also view an Advent message by Monsignor Chiodo in his Heart's Journey series to be found in the App, Website and Facebook. I hope you will have a blessed Advent as we all prepare to celebrate the birth of our Savior Jesus Christ. Happy Advent!

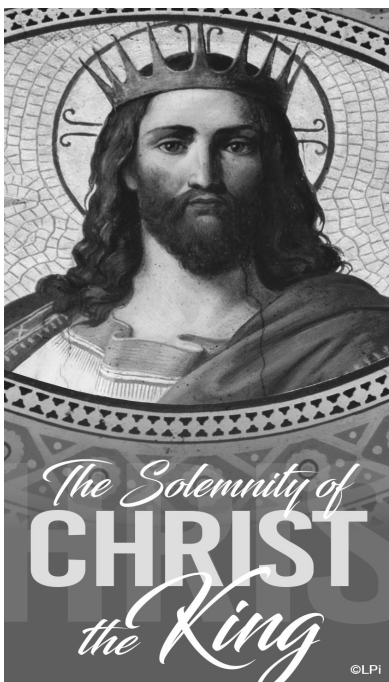

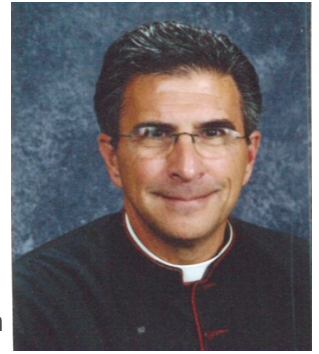
