appointment. Sun. 12:30pm-1:00pm in Spanish.

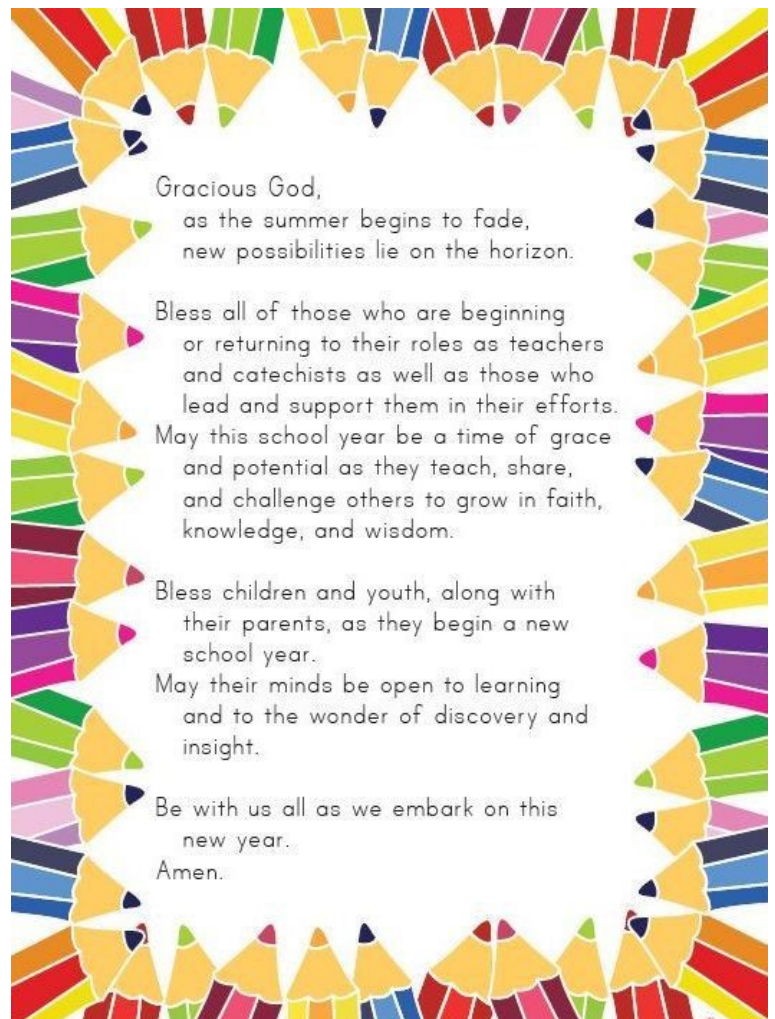
**Baptism:** Baptism is conferred by appointment on the 1st and 3rd

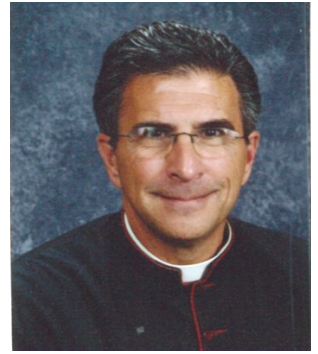
