books are available for check out.

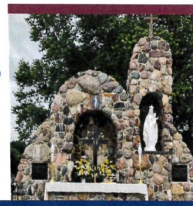

**Spiritual Adoption Program**



Beginning Sunday, September 8<sup>th</sup>, the Saint Anthony Respect Life Ministry will initiate a Spiritual Adoption Program at St. Anthony Parish. Our parishioners are encouraged to “spiritually adopt” a baby. To do this you will be asked to say the following prayer (of Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen) once a day for nine months beginning on September 8<sup>th</sup>, the Feast of the Nativity of Our Blessed Mother.

*“Jesus, Mary and Joseph I love you very much. I beg you to spare the life of the unborn baby that I have spiritually adopted who is in danger of abortion.”*

You are asked to name the child for whom you will be praying thereby acknowledging the baby’s humanity. Prayer cards with this prayer will be available in front of the Sacred Heart Altar and at the back of the church in the Respect Life Ministry display stand. In May we will have a “baby shower” where you will be invited to bring a gift for your “spiritually adopted” baby. These gifts will then be given to InnerVisions to be provided to expectant mothers and their babies.

There are millions of unborn babies desperately in need of your prayers. Won’t you please prayerfully consider “spiritually adopting” a baby and share the love for life that God has given you? Your love and prayers for the unborn and their expectant mothers and fathers will be greatly appreciated. May God bless you and your loved ones.

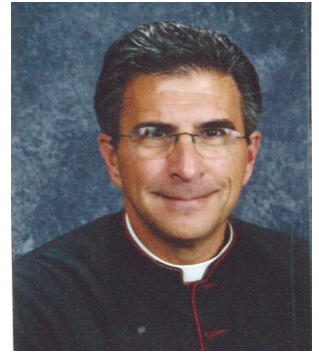
# From Msgr. Frank Chiodo
