FAITH FORMATION

Hello Parents!

This Sunday is Grandparent's Day! This day we honor those living and deceased who we owe a great debt towards. Without our grandparents, we would not exist! God's plan for their life was to bring forth new life which lead to you and your children! And, if your grandparents were Catholic, you have another incredible reason for giving them thanks today, for the gift of your Faith, for the blessing of having an intimate, one on one relationship with the Creator of all the universe! For the gift of being part of the greatest representation of God's Kingdom on Earth. For the gift of being part of a world wide work to end suffering and bring happiness to all. And for the gift of having the hope of being together for all eternity with God, the Saints, and our families. What a great day in which we celebrate all of this!

In what ways could we as a family honor our grandparents, both here on earth and in heaven, today? The best way is by spending time with them. You could take them out for lunch or dinner, You might participate in something they enjoy, such as a favorite TV show or movie. Or play together a favorite game such as cards or cribbage. If your grandparents are Catholic, find ways to work your faith into the conversation. Ask them what it felt like when Vatican II was held. What was it like growing up as a Catholic in their youth, or how did God draw them to the Catholic faith as a convert? Maybe you could attend the Traditional Latin Mass with them as a special occasion. Ask them to share one of their favorite reasons for being Catholic. (For inspiration, view video 9.4 in our parish confirmation program about the church - "Ten great reasons to be Catholic" https://dynamiccatholic.com/confirmation/program-view/session-9/) Thank them for their love, their faith, and their life. You are Catholic in large part because of them.

The communion of saints is the greatest family, and they hear our prayers daily. It's very possible that your grandparents are saints in Heaven, offer a prayer for them and to them. (see https://relevantradio.com/2018/08/can-we-ask-non-saints-to-intercede-for-us/) Our grandparents in heaven are happy to intercede on our behalf, just as they no doubt helped us every day on Earth. Offering a prayer for those in purgatory, which may also include our grandparents, would be a fitting way to show them love and honor. Please spend some time in prayer as a family today in celebration and remembrance of your grandparents! If they are living, pray over them as a family. Monsignor has a prayer in his letter this week.

One last way we can celebrate all of our ancestors in faith today is by reading together Hebrews Chapter 11. You can find it in the parish English bible on page 1636. Have members of the family take turns reading each paragraph. When you are finished, discuss as a family people from this chapter each of you feel drawn towards. Mention each of them when you close in prayer.

Often we sing this hymn at Mass. Sing it today in remembrance of these holy men and women who have come before us:

Faith of our Fathers! Holy Faith!

We will be true to thee till death.




I will be gone Sept. 9th -12th for a seminary class reunion in Denver. Interestingly, one of our classmates is the Archbishop of Denver.
