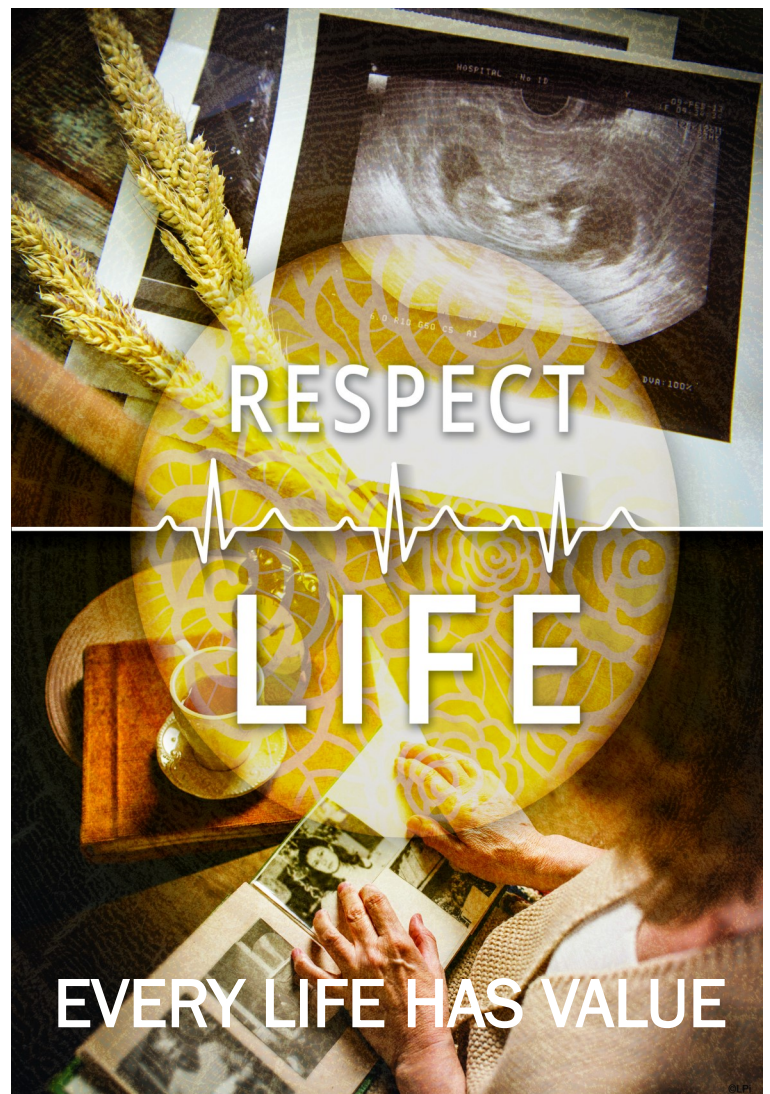
Baptism: Baptism is conferred by appointment on the 1st and 3rd

FAITH FORMATION

Hello Parents! Remember we started a journey two weeks ago as a Parish family to read together the book of Nehemiah. Let's begin our time together today with Nehemiah's prayer found in chapter 1, verses 5-11a (pages 545-6 in the parish Bible).

Where does the building and rebuilding of our Parish start? Chapter 2 verse 18b tells us: our positive attitude! And then actually following through. Verse 20 of chapter 2 reminds us that our God is with us in our efforts and He is the one who gives us success, not ourselves. Notice the picture on page 547 of Jerusalem. What do you see in this picture? Are the people working on the walls scattered around? No, they look organized, in groups.

What groups do we have in our parish for building up St Anthony's and helping Her fulfill Her mission to bring the Gospel to the world? We have several! The Altar and Rosary Society, St Vincent de Paul, Knights of Columbus, Respect Life, the Men's Prayer group, the different Councils, and the large army of Catechists dedicated to fostering relationships between our children and God, the Church, and the World. Also, there are many Hispanic groups thriving in our Parish such as the Grupo de Crecimiento, Grupo de Oración, Rosas de Maria, and others. Which one do you belong to? Could you assist another group to further the work of our Parish?

You may say, "oh I wish I could help, but I'm SO BUSY." Let's take a look at some of the people and families who were working so hard on the wall in Nehemiah's day: Chapter 3:8 - Uzziel the goldsmith (Full time goldmaker? Busy) Hananiah the perfume maker (Busy), 3:9 - Rephaiah the ruler of half the Jerusalem District (Busy? Certainly! And he built the whole section himself!) As you finish the rest of chapter 3 you'll notice many rulers who wisely used their time away from their daily jobs to help build up the city of God, Jerusalem. As a parent it's easy to say ...BUT I HAVE KIDS! For sure, that's busy, but notice in Chapter 3:12 the example of Shallum. His daughters helped with the work! What are ways that your sons or daughters could be more involved in your ministry in the Parish? What could be a better use of a families' time than sharing the Gospel together?

At the end of Mass the priest or deacon utters what phrase? "Go and announce the Gospel of the Lord!" If you are doing such by being a part of one or more of these groups, THANK YOU! We know it's not easy making time or always having the energy to keep going. The workers in Jerusalem were probably tired out from their hard labor. Their hands might have been rough and dry and their back may have been sore. But did they stop? NO! And if you aren't a part of one of these groups or other ministries in the Parish, GET INVOLVED! Being sent forth from Mass to proclaim the Gospel doesn't mean we go out to eat after church and forget about it! Talk to one of the leaders in the bulletin or call the Parish office and find out how you and your family can make a difference in building up St Anthony's and participating in Her mission.

What does the Rosary (remember October is the month of the Rosary and Mary) have to do with Nehemiah's day? Be back here in two weeks and find out? See you then!

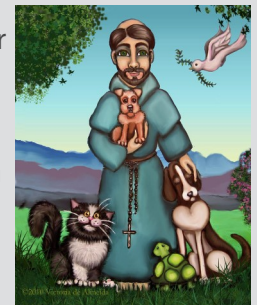
Blessing of the pets will take place on Sunday Oct. 13th after the 11:00am Mass outside of the main entrance of the church.
