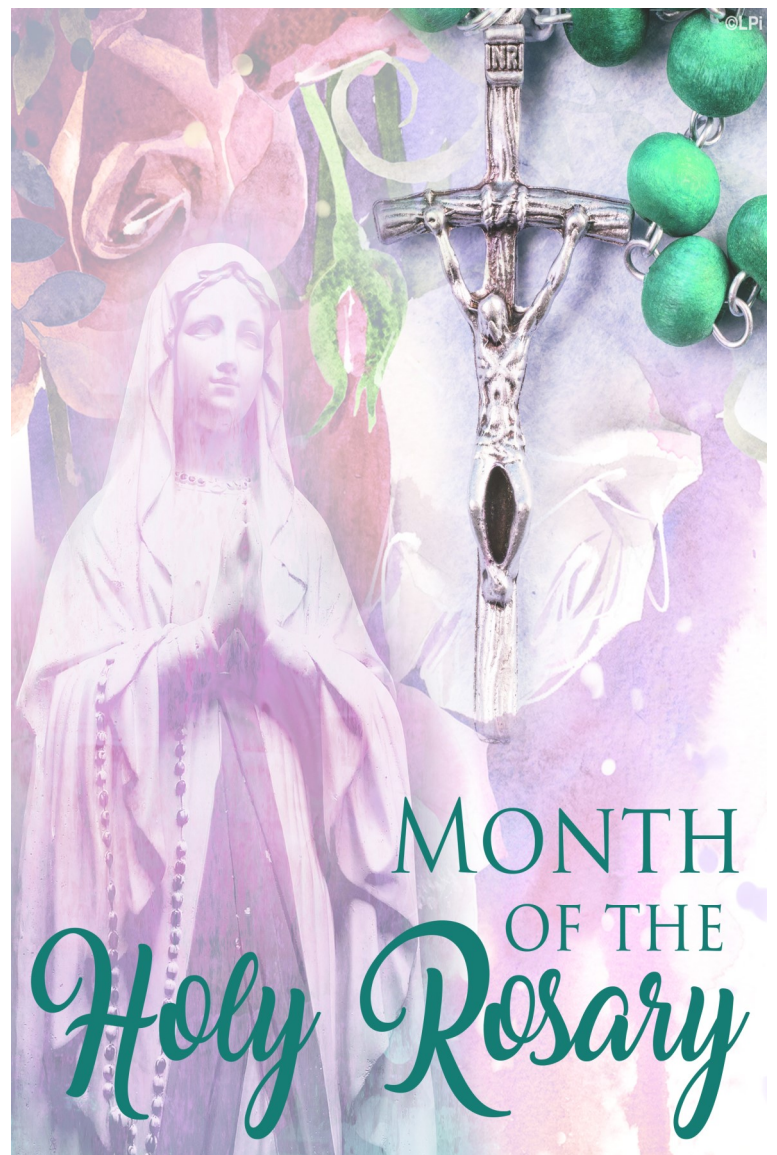
Baptism: Baptism is conferred by appointment on the 1st and 3rd

FAITH FORMATION

Greetings,

I'm thrilled to announce the Adult Faith Formation opportunities for this fall and winter. The first and foremost is the **Parish Mission scheduled during Lent on March 8th, 9th, and 10th** – Please mark your calendar for the Parish Mission and check out these studies to participate in and invite a friend.

New Study called "How to Pray Like Mary" that begins Monday October 21st from 9AM - 10:30 in the Rectory Conference Room (Free childcare). Materials are \$15, but don't let the cost prevent you from coming. You will learn a powerful practice for daily prayer as Mary models it: L-Listen, O-Observe, V-Verbalize, E-Entrust. This model is called, "L.O.V.E. the Word" -- an amazing study that will make a difference in your life.

For Advent there will be a two day retreat called, "Retreat with Mary" on Monday, December 2nd and Tuesday, December 3rd from 6pm – 8pm in the lower church. In this short Advent retreat, Dr. Brant Pitre takes you on a scriptural journey from Nazareth to Bethlehem by looking at Jesus through the eyes of the person closest to him: the Virgin Mary. In it, you will learn more about: • *The Annunciation*: • *The Visitation*: • *The Nativity*: • *Epiphany*: With each session, Dr. Pitre will help you to see the mysteries of Advent and Christmas through the eyes of Mary and with the mind of the Church. A perfect way to prepare for Christmas!

Plan now to join the Lenten study called, **"No Greater Love": A Biblical Pilgrimage that reveals Christ's Passion**. This study helps you to walk with the Lord through his passion and discover the deep love He has for you. Beginning March 16th – April 13th on Tuesdays in the Lower Church from 6pm – 8pm and or you can go to the same study on Wednesdays in the School Library 6pm – 8pm.

Starting April 20th – May 25th there will be a daytime study called, **"Follow Me" – What Do You Thirst For?** As the Good Shepherd, Jesus seeks after us. He comes to meet us and beckons us to follow him. He calls us to be his disciples, to trust him, to open ourselves to his merciful love, and to love others as he has loved us. It invites you to experience the joy of a renewed friendship with Christ. Mondays 9am – 10:30am in the Rectory Conference Room (free child care.)

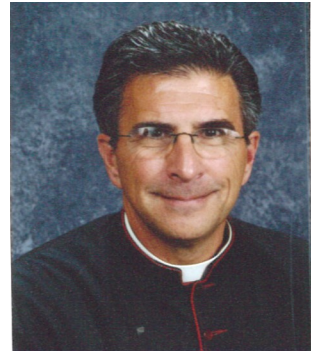
