FAITH FORMATION

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

You've heard it before...we are all on a journey. Compared to eternity, this is a short journey, and it can be difficult at times. There will be instances where God will stretch our faith and even our abilities. Then start reading the Word of God each day (start small, but every day). Ask the Holy Spirt to help you understand what the Word is saying to you personally. Remember, God really loves you and wants you to experience the peace and joy that He has stored up for you. Happy reading and talking to the Lord.
