Marriage: At least one of the parties must be registered and a practicing member of the parish. Please contact the office at least 8 months prior to the proposed date of the wedding.



ADULT AND YOUTH FAITH FORMATION

Hello Parents!

It's exciting to begin sharing with you the theme for this year that I mentioned last time. For the next several months we'll be focusing on Discerning God's Will in YOUR life. What is God's will for your life? What are your thoughts? To be kind to others, raise good Catholic children, go to mass. Yes, doing God's will definitely involves those things. But what is God's will for you specifically? Don't feel discouraged if you honestly aren't sure. This is the reason we are journeying together to find this answer.

How did parents in the Bible learn what God's will was for them? Let's take notice of an interesting example. Please open your Bible to 1 Samuel chapter 1:1 -8. (page 305 in the parish Bible) Hannah was one of two wives of Elkanah. She had tried for years to become pregnant, but had been unable. Her fellow wife was very fruitful, and was terrible to Hannah because she was barren. Having children was seen as a blessing from God.

What was Hannah going to do? Was she going to give up and stop asking God to be blessed with children? What was His will for her? Let's continue reading verses 9 to chapter 2:11. Hannah kept praying. She felt certain God's will for her was to bear a son. In fact, so strong were her feelings that she told God she would offer her son up to Him in service all the days of his life! So, now Hannah is discerning God's will for both her AND her future unborn son!

If you've finished reading, you know this story has a happy ending. Hannah is indeed blessed with a great son, Samuel, the last judge of Israel. He was used by God to accomplish His will in the nation of Israel. He lived a long life and loved God.
