Greetings in Christ,

It's Lent—a time of renewal! A time of having a spotlight put on our spiritual life. It's a time to be more focused on Christ and dying to self. So, if your daily life during Lent has no changes, you may be missing out.

Lent is when we strive to imitate our Lord. Of course, he went out to the desert to pray and fast for 40 days without any food—something we don't come close to doing. However, we can and should pray more. We can do things that help prepare ourselves to commune with the Lord. Lent is like preparing for an athletic race. And like an athlete, the Christian during Lent can discipline the flesh through fasting and prayer—a spiritual workout every day. We should push ourselves beyond what is easy.

Make a plan of what you could do to prepare for Easter. Fasting during Lent is critical so that you exercise the "will" over "want." Then it is important to think about giving to others. You can join the parish in giving each week to the groups St. Vincent de Paul has lined up. The bulletin has the list for you to use.

You may also consider going to the *Lenten Parish Mission*...if you haven't signed up yet. There will also be a Bible Study starting the last week of March called "No Greater Love." I would encourage you to sign up for that. It takes you through the Passion of Christ like I've never seen before. It's a powerful study—more to come. May you have a blessed Lent and grow in your faith!

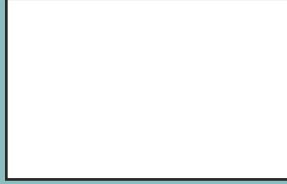
