SACRAMENTS

Reconciliation: Confession may not be celebrated in common, but only individually at the Monsignor Chiodo's discretion. The conditions for administration of general absolution are NOT present, and to gather for this purpose defeats the aim to minimize spread of coronavirus COVID-19.

Baptism: Baptism in cases of serious illness or other pastoral need, may not be celebrated in common, but only individually at the priest's discretion with serious pastoral necessity. Standard health norms should be respected

Marriage: Nuptial Masses already scheduled may be celebrated with the 10 person limit; ideally, these Masses should be rescheduled after government leaders give the "all clear" notice. Any and all other public

leaders give the "all clear" notice. Any and all other public ceremonies should be rescheduled.

Funeral: Please contact a funeral home and they will notify the parish office. Per the Bishops order during the coronavirus crisis, funerals will be limited to 10 people in the church.



FROM MONSIGNOR CHIODO, PASTOR



My Brothers and Sisters in the Lord, I use the salutation deliberately, since at times like these we must be reminded that we are all part of God's family, and care and compassion are at the heart of our relationship. May the Lord keep our eyes, ears, hands and hearts open to the needs of those around us.

One of the greatest challenges we face—along with staying physically healthy—is to remain spiritually healthy. Although we are required to "fast" from Holy Communion for a time, we can tune in and watch the daily Mass and devotions online. More details in the Mass Schedule. Spiritual communion is also encouraged. This is a time when we receive the Lord spiritually—not in the Blessed Sacrament—through prayer and meditation. Here is a sample prayer for spiritual communion:

O DIVINE SAVIOR, I COME BEFORE YOU RECOGNIZING THE HUNGER OF MY HEART FOR YOUR PRESENCE. MY HEART CRIES OUT IN NEED FOR YOUR MERCY. ALTHOUGH I CANNOT RECEIVE YOU IN HOLY COMMUNION, I ASK YOU TO ENTER MY HEART, BODY AND SOUL SPIRITUALLY. OPEN ME TO THE INFILLING OF YOUR PRESENCE SO THAT I MAY COME TO EXPERIENCE IN A NEW WAY THE POWER OF YOUR HEALING, LIGHT, SERENITY AND PEACE. MAY I YEARN MORE INTENSELY FOR THE DAY I CAN RECEIVE YOU ONCE AGAIN IN THE EUCHARIST—BODY, BLOOD, SOUL AND DIVINITY.~AMEN.

The church remains open for Eucharistic Adoration and prayer. The Rosary is being prayed at 6pm for 40 days. In every experience God is delivering a message. It can be as simple as "I love you." Ask the Lord to reveal to your heart the message for you—during this crisis. God's messages always bring a challenge to draw closer to His merciful heart. Amidst the circling cauldron of chaos around us, the Source of Peace is with us. Listen closely.....
