



FAITH FORMATION

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The Gospel on Sunday is Jesus walking on water during a storm. When the disciples saw him, they were terrified. It says they "cried out in fear" thinking Jesus was a ghost. The Lords words to them were, "Take courage, it is I."

This is right after the Lord had fed over five thousand men with only five loaves of bread and two fish. The disciples were in the midst of witnessing one miracle after another. When Peter recognized the Lord, he asked the Him to command him to come to Him on the water. Jesus simply said, "Come." Peter, for a moment, was actually walking on water but then he let fear enter in. What strikes me about this is the Lord's question to Peter..."Why did you doubt?" That is the question we should all ask ourselves. Why do we doubt the Lord? He has shown himself faithful. He is the Creator. We certainly know that He loves us. There is nothing impossible for Him.

Maybe a good request for the Lord is to ask for more courage to trust Him, so that we can be in a life storm, and yet, be able to tune it out because of Him. Courage is the combination of knowing the truth and standing your ground in that truth. When the lies come, you must reject them. Find that place in your heart where you've already resolved what you believe and just trust the Lord.

Lean on Jesus. In fact, make it a mission to get to know your Lord better. Listen to Him through the Holy Scriptures. Accept His discipline with thankfulness—it's great for humility. We are always in training as disciples. That's why we must also be quick to forgive one another. Training in holiness can be difficult at times and regular prayer, going to Mass, and sharing in each other burdens is important on this journey.

Remember, there is no fruit apart from Jesus, so all your work must be in Him and through Him. Take Courage and walk on water with the Lord! Don't let fear keep you from what God has called you to do.
