While we are watching the kids play soccer we might bring a treat along. Curled up on the couch with a loved one watching a romantic movie we might be munching on something tasty. In all these cases we have the choice of either something good for us, which helps us on our journey to become the best version of ourselves, or something not healthy for us, which leads us in the opposite direction. What are some examples of spiritually healthy snacks families can enjoy? They should be fun, spiritually healthy, and easy to consume both at home and on the go. I'd like to share some great apps, websites, books, and videos that can help your family get some sorely needed joy and spirituality in today's gloomy world.

My go to app every day is pray as you go. You can find the app in the Google and Apple app stores for free or at their website <https://pray-as-you-go.org/>. There are versions in Spanish and also for spanish speaking children ages 7-11. You will find every day a new reflection based on scripture, some amazing music from all places and times, and some deep questions to ponder. They also offer free on demand retreats with topics such as the daily examen, healthcare workers, comfort for the lonely and other mental health challenges. They even have a walking prayer so you can walk with God both physically and spiritually.

More great spiritual snacks can be found at <https://www.catholiccentral.com/>. Your family will be entertained by the antics of Kai and Libby as they help you learn more about your faith. Almost every topic has been covered by them over the years. We use their videos frequently with youth in confirmation classes to give them more coverage on important topics. Using this site you can sit down as a family and learn something new and fun each day!

The latest edition of Catholic Prayer for Catholic Families is available now. You can ask me for one or request a copy from the parish office at no charge. This amazing prayer book will help you as an individual and as a family begin, expand, and strengthen your daily prayer. By learning first how to pray and the many forms of prayer, you and your family will be able to pray with scripture, use your imagination in prayer, offer prayer in your own words, and understand the many ways God speaks to us. We have used the previous green cover version of the booklet for several years, and this new blue cover edition is fantastic!

Monsignor and Fr Reynaldo both have Youtube channels now. They offer a variety of locally flavored spiritual encouragement and direction based on the needs of our families at St Anthony's. Please continue to support our locally produced high quality spiritual snacks!
