The Prayer Process Part One

Hello Parents!

Confirmation year two students are learning a life changing habit this month in class: how to pray.

Why Pray? The answer is actually very simple: because you want to be happy. If there is a God, and if that God has a plan for your life, then trying to find happiness outside of that plan is impossible. Discovering God's beautiful plan for your life is essential to your happiness—and should be your highest priority. I know you have lots of other priorities at the moment, but a day will come in your life when you'll realize that everything you thought was important is second to discovering God's plan for your life. The sooner that day comes, the better your life will be. You will never be happy doing something other than God's will. So the question becomes: How do we discover God's will for our lives? One of the ways we discover God's will is through regular prayer.

There is only one question and one course of action that leads to lasting happiness in this changing world: *God, what do you think I should do?* It is a mistake to think that we can find happiness without asking this question.

Our lives change when our habits change. Are you ready for your life to change? Before learning the prayer process, begin with inviting more silence into your life.

Antiphon, "Rejoice". Rose vestments are worn to
emphasize our joy that Christmas is near, and we also
light the rose candle on our Advent wreath.
It is named the shepherd candle or candle of joy.

Gaudete (English: /gaudeɪteɪ/ GOW-day-tay, Ecclesiastical Latin: [gauˈdete]; "rejoice [ye]" in Latin).


