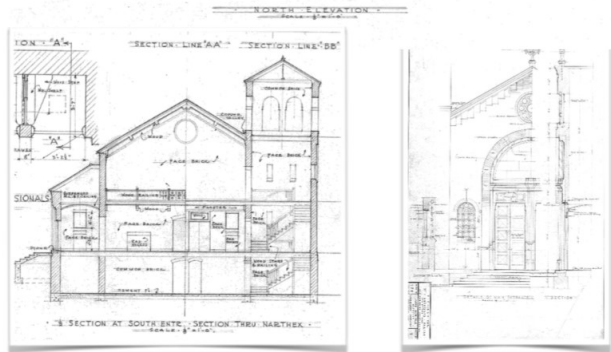
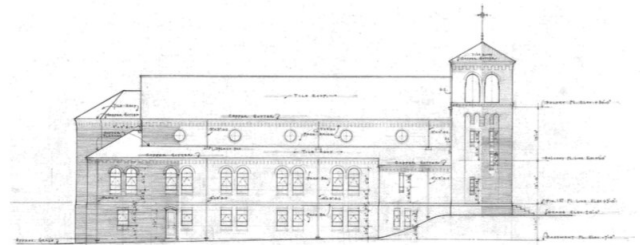

My Fellow Travelers along the road to Calvary,

One of my favorite Lenten hymns which is quite appropriate for Holy Week has these words: "*Were You There When They Crucified My Lord?*" Yes, this week we answer that question, because during the liturgies of this most holiest of weeks,

we become pray fully present at the Last Supper, on Calvary where we experience the power of Christ's cross, and at the empty tomb to experience the grace of the resurrection.

Plan to join us at church if possible, or stream the liturgies. As the hymn puts it: "Oh, oh, sometimes it causes me to wonder, wonder, wonder. Were you there when they crucified my Lord?" Yes, and we shall be there again this week.

**Holy Thursday, April 1:** 5:30pm Solemn Latin Mass and 7:00pm solemn mass and procession of the Blessed Sacrament / Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament until 9:00pm.

**Good Friday, April 2:** 3:00pm — Solemn Service, 5:00pm — Online Spanish Stations of the Cross, 7:00pm — Bilingual - Stations of the Cross.

**Easter Vigil Saturday, April 3:** 7:30pm — Bilingual Solemn, Baptism & Confirmation of New Members

**Easter Sunday, April 4:** 8:00am — English (Church), 8:00am — Spanish (Parish Hall), 9:30am — Solemn Latin, 11:00am — English Solemn Mass, 1:00pm — Spanish.

Remember Good Friday is a day of fasting—only one meal and the others light and nothing in between meals. No meat. The obligation to abstain from meat applies to every one over the age of 15, unless illness prohibits it. The obligation to fast ends at the age of 59.

There are a few highlights that I would like to bring to your attention this week that are worth noting.

First, there is an Easter Candle basket for sale for those who are interested. This is available thanks to our brothers and sisters in the Hispanic Community who requested to have these available and who a labor of love put the baskets together. The Easter Candle is blessed and comes with an explanation of how the candle was made and its purpose. In the basket with the candle is also a container for Holy Water, the Divine Mercy prayer and a Divine Mercy picture. The basket is \$30 and there are only thirty available. We hope to have them in the elevator foyer after Mass. If not, they will be in the parish office.

Second, St. Anthony has a new book, "*St. Anthony Catholic Church, Building A Missionary Church for the Southside of Des Moines,*" that highlights its history and gives details about the church building. It was put together so that the next generation can know about the faith and life of the people who started the church. In addition, if the Church is entered into the Register of Historic Places, visitors would be able to use the book to learn of its history. The book will be available after Easter and can be reserved in advance upon request. The cost is a donation of \$15 or whatever you can afford. You may email or text me to reserve a book.

Finally, the Diocese has put together an online sign up to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet as part of an effort to have the prayer going continually for a 24 hours. This is a beautiful idea, especially as we draw closer to Divine Mercy Sunday. I would encourage you to sign up to pray.
