## CATECHISM HIGHLIGHTS

Topic: "And Forgive Us Our Trespasses, as We Forgive Those Who Trespass Against Us."

2838 This petition is astonishing. If it consisted only of the first phrase, "and forgive us our trespasses, " it might have been included, implicitly, in the first three petitions of the Lord's Prayer, since Christ's sacrifice is 'that sins may be forgiven." But, according to the second phrase, our petition will not be heard unless we have first met a strict requirement. Our petition looks to the future, but our response must come first, for the two parts are joined by the single word "as".

#### And forgive us our trespasses...

2839 With bold confidence, we began praying to our Father. In begging him that his name be hallowed, we were in fact asking him that we ourselves might be always made more holy. But though we are clothed with the baptismal garment, we do not cease to sin, to turn away from God. Now, in this new petition, we return to him like the prodigal son and, like the tax collector, recognize that we are sinners before him. Our petition begins with a "confession" of our wretchedness and his mercy. Our hope is firm because, in his Son, "we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins." We find the efficacious and undoubted sign of his forgiveness in the sacraments of his Church.

Sunday, June 13, 9am—8pm Procession to the Grotto after 11am Mass





Rev. Chris Saenz, a Columan Missionary, will preach at St. Anthony the weekend of June 19-20.

Fr. Chris Saenz is a native of Bellevue, Nebraska. He was ordained a Columban missionary priest in 2000.

Fr. Saenz missioned seventeen years in Chile, participating in diverse ministries such as: rural, urban, indigenous, spiritual direction, The Missionary Society of St. Columban was formally founded in 1918 and takes its name from St. Columban, Ireland's sixth century missionary to Europe. They work in Australia, New Zealand, Brazil, Britain, Ireland, China, Chile, Hong Kong, Fiji, Ireland, Japan, Korea, Myanmar, Pakistan, Peru, Philippines, Taiwan, Rome, Mexico and the United States.

Through living and ministering among peoples of other cultures and traditions, they witness to their belief that all peoples are children of the one God and brothers and sisters in Christ. In those countries they are unable to preach the Gospel openly yet continue to offer support to small and vulnerable Christian communities through our presence with them in their struggles. They invite people who have been abandoned or forgotten by society to find support and hope in vibrant faith communities. In the U.S., they continue to invite all the baptized to share in the universal mission of the Church through actively supporting our various missionary endeavors or through exploring the missionary dimensions of their own faith with us in a cross-cultural setting.
