## FR. GUTHRIE DOLAN



Dear Parishioners,

I would like to invite you to special events the next two Sundays.

June 12<sup>th</sup>, we will be celebrating the Feast of St. Anthony of Padua, patron saint of our parish. St. Anthony was born in Lisbon, Portugal, where he became a Franciscan Priest and set sail to evangelize the Muslims in Morocco. He ended up shipwrecked on Sicily. From there he journeyed to Assisi to find St. Francis, who sent him to the town of Padua (Padova today). While in Italy, he gained a reputation as a great preacher and a holy priest. He died on June 13<sup>th</sup> (his actual feast day), 1231 at the age of 35. Clearly I have a long way to go to his holiness, since God's kept me here longer.

Sunday, June 19<sup>th</sup> will be our annual Corpus Christi Eucharistic Procession. 11:00 Mass will be at the Grotto and Bilingual. We will begin the procession through the neighborhood shortly after Mass. When we return, we will celebrate Msgr. Chiodo's retirement as a parish family. He will be awarded the "Pillar of the Parish" and we will give him our parish retirement gift. I hope and pray that he is well enough to attend. However, if he is not, we will have his family there on his behalf.

As a reminder, any retirement gifts you want to send Msgr. Chiodo should be sent to the parish office and made out to St. Anthony's Catholic Church. We will combine them and give him one check to make less work for him.

Finally, this is the last weekend for St. Anthony to host the Latin Mass. Know that you will always belong here and be close to our hearts. God bless all of you who are transferring to St. Augustin's.

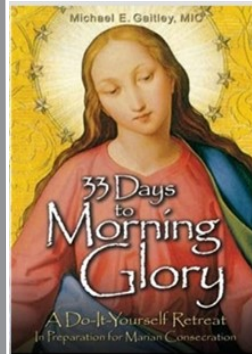

This is based off the classic guide to preparation, but it focuses less on long prayers and more on learning more about Jesus and Mary and consecration through the eyes of St. John Paul II, St. Maximilian Kolbe, St. Teresa of Calcutta, and St. Louis De Montfort.

The preparation leads up to a **special day**, the day on which you make an act of consecration. It's recommended that you go to Mass that day and Confession, that you set aside special time for prayer, and that you even sign a written act of consecration.

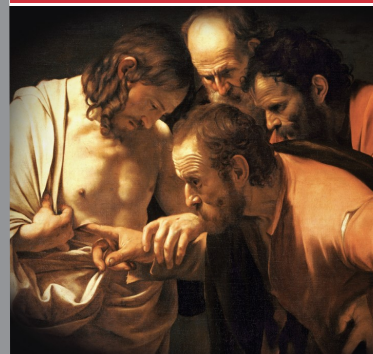
