Dear brothers and sisters

On July 14th, 2011, I began my first assignment as parochial vicar of St. Anthony's under Msgr. Chiodo. It seems fitting, then, that on July 14th of this year Msgr. Chiodo and I officially end our time at St. Anthony's together. These last eleven years have been a true blessing for me, and that's thanks to a wonderful and caring pastor who has been an example for me these first years of priesthood. I remember leaving St. Anthony in 2013. Driving away that day was one of the hardest things I've ever done. I imagine this weekend will be similar.

I never imagined the friendship I would develop with Msgr. Chiodo back when I was first assigned. And, given my own mental state when I was reassigned here in 2019, I wasn't sure it was going to make it through a second assignment. My first time at St. Anthony's helped set me on a course for being a holy and pious priest. This second round has taught me the grace of suffering. I was at a very low place when I arrived. We lived through the 2020 pandemic together and the isolation that brought us all. We learned to cut our own hair (and I cut Msgr. Chiodo's!). St. Anthony's was ahead of the pack on broadcasting live services on the internet, which I played a role in by upgrading the system in autumn of 2019. And now, with Msgr. Chiodo being ill, I've had to take care of a sick pastor and the whole parish. I've grown closer to each one of you, and that has been a blessing.

CATECHISM MEDITATIONS

Topic: Love your Neighbor as Yourself

Jesus said to his disciples: "Love one another even as I have loved you."¹

2196 In response to the question about the first of the commandments, Jesus says: "The first is, 'Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one; and you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength.' The second is this, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these."²

2822 Our Father "desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth."⁹⁵ He "is forbearing toward you, not wishing that any should perish."⁹⁶ His commandment is "that you love one another; even as I have loved you, that you also love one another."⁹⁷ This commandment summarizes all the others and expresses his entire will.
