

Advanced Junior Training Camp

From the Northwest Ministries Network JLDA Coordinator:

AJTC Prerequisites: Young men who are *graduates* of the 7th Grade or above* may attend AJTC. As a prerequisite, you *must* have attended Junior Training Camp, and have earned at least two (2) Leadership Merits. *Young men who are in a grade above the 8th Grade, who have also completed JTC can attend, especially if you want to earn the Trail of the Saber Award.

Curriculum: AJTC is now based on a Servant-Leadership learning model rather than the previous advanced camping-skills model. It has also changed from the advanced "boot-camp" style to more of a participative, mentoring, thought provoking, scenario-based model. Boys will learn how to interact with each other, how to properly run a Royal Ranger Outpost Meeting, how to implement the Patrol System at your Outpost, Advanced Leadership techniques, challenges, and many other aspects of how to be a Junior Leader. You will be challenged in a spiritual way to learn how The Lord influences and guides your life.

Tent Camping and Meals: We will be staying in outdoor tents at Lost Creek Camp in Naches, Washington. All meals will be served in the lodge café, so camp attendees will not be cooking meals as they were at past JTC and AJTC camps. Camp participants will sleep together with their Patrol Members. Due to a donation, the camp fee this year is \$110.00 instead of the normal \$150.00.

You will be led by experienced and caring Royal Ranger Leaders who love mentoring, and who want for you to succeed! *Join us, and bring young men in your Outpost with you!* Note: There may be partial scholarships for students who cannot afford the tuition for this camp. There are no full scholarships because we feel that in order to learn how to be a leader, a young man should put some "sweat equity" into the payment for the camp, and earn part of his camp fees. 
