

Junior Leadership Development Academy

From the Northwest Ministries Network JLDA Coordinator:

Junior Training Camp (JTC) Prerequisites: Young men who have <u>completed</u> the 6th Grade, and are going into the 7th Grade or above* at the time of the Camp Application Deadline can apply for this camp. As prerequisites, we highly recommend *but do not require* that you have earned the Toolcraft and the Firecraft merits. We do require that you have earned at least one (1) Leadership Merit (any course number from 101 through 306). *If you are in the 7th Grade, or even grades above that (8th, 9th, etc.), you can apply to this camp for the purposes of earning the Trail of the Saber Award or if you just want to attend the camp.

Curriculum: JTC is now based on a Servant-Leadership learning model rather than the previous campingskills model. It has also changed from the "boot-camp" style to more of a participative, mentoring, thought provoking, scenario-based model. Boys will learn how to interact with each other, how to properly run a Royal Ranger Outpost Meeting, The Patrol System, Leadership techniques, challenges, and many other aspects of how to be a Junior Leader. You will be challenged in a spiritual way to learn how The Lord influences and guides your life.

Camping in Tents, Meals and Fees: We will be staying in outdoor tents at Lost Creek Village Camp near Naches, WA, with full access to the Bathhouse with hot showers and porcelain toilets. All meals will be served in the main lodge café, so camp attendees will not be cooking meals as they were at past JTC and AJTC camps. Camp participants will sleep together with their Patrol Members. Note that attendees will not have to cook any of their meals. Due to a donation, the camp fee this year is \$110.00 instead of the normal \$150.00.

You will be led by experienced and caring Royal Ranger Leaders who love mentoring, and who want for you to succeed! *Join us, and bring young men in your Outpost with you!* Note: There may be partial scholarships for students who cannot afford the tuition for this camp. There are no full scholarships because we feel that in order to learn how to be a leader, a young man should put some "sweat equity" into the payment for the camp, and earn part of his camp fees. The **Junior Leadership Development Academy (JLDA)** is designed to assist a boy in his leadership journey. It consists of several events that are held annually that will give boys fun-filled, intentional leadership training, along with powerful spiritual development opportunities. This training experience is designed to be a catalyst and springboard of spiritual encouragement.

What is the Junior Training Camp? (JTC) is a district training event for boys who have completed the 6th Grade, and are going into the 7th Grade or above. JTC focuses on leadership development in the local patrol and group. JTC can be offered in a camping, retreat center, or church venue. JTC is a *required* event for the Trail of the Saber Award. JTC will help boys discover answers to these questions:

- What are my God-given (natural) talents and strengths and how am I developing them?
 - Do I have what it takes to be a godly man?
 - What is God's plan for my life?



Directions

From I-90 east and I-82 south, take Exit 31 and HWY 12 west towards White Pass/Naches.

At White Pass/Chinook Pass intersection, stay right and take HWY 410 /Chinook Pass west. After Mile Marker 99 and Gold Creek Station Restaurant, take a left on Old River Rd. Take a left on Lost Creek Rd. (NF 311 - dirt /gravel road). Follow Lost Creek Rd. approx 1 1/2 miles to camp.

From HWY 410/ Chinook Pass east, 3.8 miles past Whistlin' Jack Lodge

Take a right on Old River Rd. Take a left on Lost Creek Rd. (NF 311 - dirt /gravel road). Follow Lost Creek Rd. approx 1 1/2 miles to camp.
