

## **Ranger Training Camp**

From the Northwest Ministries Network JLDA Coordinator:

Ranger Training Camp (RTC) is part of the Junior Leadership Development Academy.

**RTC Prerequisites**: Young men who are graduates of the 4<sup>th</sup> Grade as of June 30, but not yet in the 7<sup>th</sup> Grade may attend RTC. i.e. Going into 5<sup>th</sup> or 6<sup>th</sup> Grade in September of this year. As prerequisites, we highly recommend (but not require) that you have earned and at least one (1) Leadership Merit (any course number).

**Curriculum:** RTC prepares boys to serve as junior leaders in a boy-led, adult-facilitated outpost. The Northwest Ministries Network RTC will be offered in a camping venue at Lost Creek Village, which is the same location, and the same week as Ranger Camp.

RTC will help boys discover answers to these questions:

- What is my role in my patrol and group?
- What are some of my God-given (natural) talents and strengths?
- How do I add value to my patrol and group?
- What responsibilities can I undertake to help my patrol and group

You will be challenged in a spiritual way to learn how The Lord influences and guides your life.

**Camping in Tents, Meals and Fees:** You will be staying in tents at Lost Creek with a near-by bath house with porcelain toilets and shower facilities,. All meals will be served in the lodge café, so camp attendees will not be cooking. Camp participants will sleep together with their Patrol Members. Due to a donation, the Ranger Training Camp fee this year is \$110.00 instead of the normal \$150.00.

You will be led by experienced and caring Royal Ranger Leaders who love mentoring, and who want for you to succeed! *Join us, and bring young men in your Outpost with you!* Note: There *may* be partial scholarships for students who cannot afford the tuition for this camp. There are no full scholarships because we feel that in order to learn how to be a leader, a young man should put some "sweat equity" into the payment for the camp, and earn part of his camp fees. In addition, I authorize and consent to all medical, surgical, diagnostic, and hospital procedures as may be performed or prescribed by a physician to safeguard my child's health, and it is not advisable to take the time to contact me in advance. I waive my right to informed consent for such treatment.

Moreover, I understand that temporary emergency measures may be necessary to safeguard my child's health, and I do hereby authorize and request THE NORTHWEST DISTRICT COUNCIL OF THE ASSEMBLIES OF GOD personnel to administer or supervise such treatment and to do any procedure that they deem necessary until such time as my child can be safely transported to a doctor or hospital.


## **RTC Personal Equipment Checklist**

#### From I-90 east and I-82 south, take Exit 31 and HWY 12 west towards White Pass/Naches.

At White Pass/Chinook Pass intersection, stay right and take HWY 410 /Chinook Pass west. After Mile Marker 99 and Gold Creek Station Restaurant, take a left on Old River Rd. Take a left on Lost Creek Rd. (NF 311 - dirt /gravel road). Follow Lost Creek Rd. approx 1 1/2 miles to camp.

### From HWY 410/ Chinook Pass east, 3.8 miles past Whistlin' Jack Lodge

Take a right on Old River Rd. Take a left on Lost Creek Rd. (NF 311 - dirt /gravel road). Follow Lost Creek Rd. approx 1 1/2 miles to camp.
