

### Sermon Based Questions for January 14, 2018

- 1) Have you ever asked these questions “What am I doing here?”  
“Why God, would You put me in this situation, at this time?”  
“What purpose could God possibly have for me right here & now?”
- 2) What did you think about Pastor Dan’s answers as to what these questions reveal about us? Do you agree? Would you add anything?
- 3) Can you think of an example when God’s future plan in your life was revealed & brought about through a current situation you were in?
- 4) How might God be preparing you for something ahead through your current circumstances/positions/obligations?
- 5) Read the parable of the talents found in Matthew 25:14-30. What can we learn from this teaching about how God gives and how God takes away opportunities?
- 6) What needs do you see around you that God might be calling you to pray, plan and prepare to do something about?
- 7) What seemed most impossible to you about Nehemiah’s situation/ circumstances as “cupbearer to the king of Persia” that would have led you to believe that this was a “mission impossible” task to be the one God would use to rebuild the wall in Jerusalem?
- 8) There are five words that start with the letter “O” that represent the way God brought Nehemiah to a place where He used him in mighty ways in accordance with His redemptive plan (the last 5 bullet points in the sermon). Which one(s) were most impactful to you and why?
- 9) What is one practical thing you can do this week to apply what you have learned from this sermon?

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
