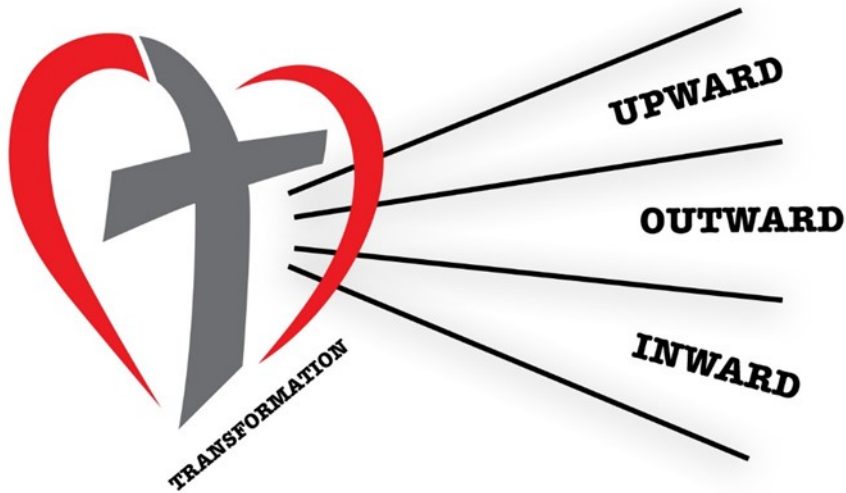

Love INC Personal Care Pantry

These missions help local people in need receive food, clothing, and personal care items.

The Food Pantry is an 100% volunteer run organization which provide a three day emergency supply of *food* (based on household size) to eligible families once each calendar month.

Community Services helps residents throughout all of Medina County with Clothing, Food, Household Items, Furniture, and Children's Toys. They always need blankets, and sheets.

Personal Care Pantry is a ministry that meets at the Brunswick Church of the Nazarene that serves people of Brunswick in need. They need all items that can't be purchased with food stamps like toiletries, q-tips, feminine products, paper towels, cleaning supplies, detergents, soaps, etc.

This month we are asking for any donations to go into our totes across from the kitchen.

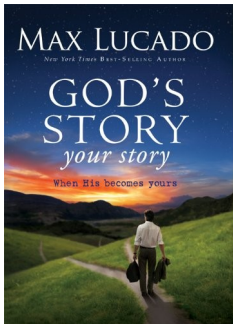
