Why are we studying the book of Acts?

- If we lost the book of Acts we would have very little to no <u>history</u> of the early church.
 - It is a sequel to the Gospel of Luke, and Luke tells us that these books are to give us historical proof to what we have been taught.
- To see the development from a small movement, to a worldwide movement.
- As we study the book of Acts we must remember that we are to emulate the <u>biblical principles</u> outlined in this book, not just try and duplicate everything said in Acts.

The Four Main Details of our passage:

- 1. A command for the disciples to stay in Jerusalem, when Jesus promises that they will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.
 - a. We know this is memorable because they <u>obeyed</u> this command, and we will see what happened at Pentecost.
 - b. The disciples were in danger staying in Jerusalem
- 2. Jesus' <u>graceful</u> answer to yet another bad question from the disciples.
 - a. He re-directs their question to an amazing truth.
 - i. We don't need to know every detail of God's plan
 - ii. Instead of giving us answers, he gave us <u>power</u> through the Holy Spirit.

- 3. Jesus telling his disciples, and <u>us</u>, that we will be his witnesses.
 - a. The book of Acts is showing us how the disciples fulfilled the Great Commission.
 - b. There are 2 ways to witness, with your <u>words</u> and your <u>deeds.</u>

i. We need to do both

- 4. Jesus is going to return someday
 - a. Don't get discouraged with the bad things of this world, because we know that Jesus will return someday to make things the way that they should be.
