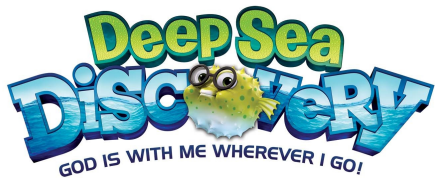

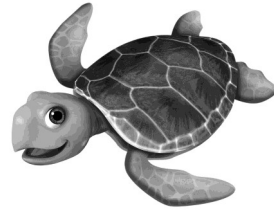


Operation BRC!

VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL!

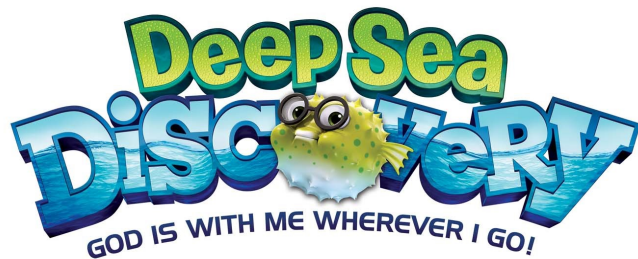
Can you believe it, June is here! You know what that means, it is time for Vacation Bible School!

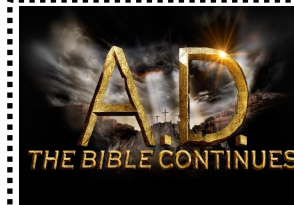
High school camp is July 21-July 26th (INCLUDES TIDAL WAVE!)
